The Historical Setting

The birth of Jesus really took place about four years prior to the beginning of the account designated Anno Domini. Through a misunderstanding as to the date of Herod's death, chronologists dated Christ's 'birth too late. Later investigation revealed this error, and we now know that Jesus was born in the year which we would have to call 4 B.C., and His death took place in the year A.D. 30 instead of A.D. 33, as formerly supposed. As to Luke, the author of the third Gospel and the Book of Acts, we have no way of determining whether he was a Hellen istic Jew or Gentile proselyte, but the first view is the more probable. He became a companion of second missionary journey, joining the company at Troas and going only on the ears of the shepherds! with them to Macedonia. Fro.n that time until the martyrdom of the apostle he remained with him except for short intervals when he faith. He was Paul's sole companion in his second imprisonment (2) Tim. 4:11).
