Notice that he Permanent Waving aid not use this title lightly or hypocritically (Matt. 7:21). but as signifying Christ's right to command - "Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?" That is the very heart of conversion. We have a practice of offering Jesus as Saviour, leaving the invitation to accept Him as Lord to some later time. This is not New Testament procedure. It was recently pointed out to me that nowhere in the New Testament is Jesus called "Saviour and Lord," but He is called "Lord and Saviour" (2 Pet. 1: 11; 2; 20; 3; 2, 18; see also Titus 1:4). It is as Lord that He is Saviour, and the Apostle Paul teaches us that our salvation is wrapped up in our confessing Him as Lord (Rom. 10:9. A.S.V.) as a corollary of believing. The fact is that no man is morally capable of receiving salvation until he

owns the lordship of Christ.
