## Approve \$100,000 For County Paving

Ontario County Council has received permission from the Provincial Dept. of Hgys. to issue debentures up to \$100,000 for the construction of new pavement in the county. A special meeting of the Council is being held today to decide where the paving will be laid. If the 25 miles are completed, the county's paved road mileage will be increased 50 per cent County Road Superintendent, R.E. Sims said yesterday. Further, it will represent the largest road construction undertaken in the County since it was organized. The decision of the Department of Highways, which cut the county's road budget for this year substantially, thus ruling out any possibility of new paving, is big news, and will no doubt, be well received by the county legislators. The Council has long felt that to do so much paving per year is in the long run the most economical, but the lack of funds has been a stumbling block. The traffic on county roads today is greater than it ever was, and roads will have to be constructed to take care of it.

## Ontario Act Amended To Aid Retarded

The Ontario Education Dept. will subsidize the education of retarded children to the extent of \$250 a pupil annually under an amendment to the Education Act published last week. The grant will be paid to parent groups on the basis of average daily attendance for each month in which classes operate. The Ontario Association for Retarded Children is responsible for statements to the deputy minister giving full statistics. Children up to 18 years of age, incapable of development beyond the mentality of a child of eight, must be admitted free of charge.

## Amend Bylaw Allow Estate Be Hospital

The Ontario Municipal Board Thursday approved an amendment to the Langstaff-Thornhill zoning bylaw in Markham Twp., to permit erection of a private hospital on the estate of the late George McCullagh, former publisher of The Telegram and Globe and Mail. No residents appeared at the Municipal Board hearing and Markham deputy reeve Alfred LeMasurier spoke in favour of the amendment. He pointed out the hospital would mean some \$1,000 in taxes annually for the township. Dr. E.E. Shouldice, who plans to build the hospital on the 135-acre estate, declined to say how much it would cost. He has not yet applied for a building permit. The zoning bylaw had limited the area to residential development only. The estate is situated on Bayview, just east of Thornhill.

## Scott Named CCF Candidate

A naval veteran, Donald Scott, 29, was unanimously elected as the CCF candidate in the forthcoming federal election for York North at a nomination meeting held last week in the fire hall auditorium, Newmarket.

The meeting was chaired by Kenneth Bryden, a former de-

puty minister of labor for Saskatchewan who is the Ontario provincial CCF secretary. Speaking in support of the candidate was Charles Millard, the CCF candidate for York West. Mr. Millard represented that riding in the provincial legislature until the '51 elections. He is the national director of the United Steelworkers' Association and one of the vice-presidents of the Canadian Congress of Labor.

Also present at the meeting which drew a crowd of less than 50, were Dudley Bristow,

CCF candidate for Rosedale, and Margaret Newcombe, wife of the CCF candidate for York Center, Bill Newcombe. It was on the motion of Mrs. Eva Bristol, Woodbridge, and Douglas Carter, Richmond Hill that the riding decided to nominate a candidate for the election. Mr. Carter named Donald Scott. Mr. Scott, Wilson Heights, is a graduate of the University of Toronto having taken his B.A. degree there under the DVA after the last war. He is married and has two children, Donna, 5, and Robert, 4.
