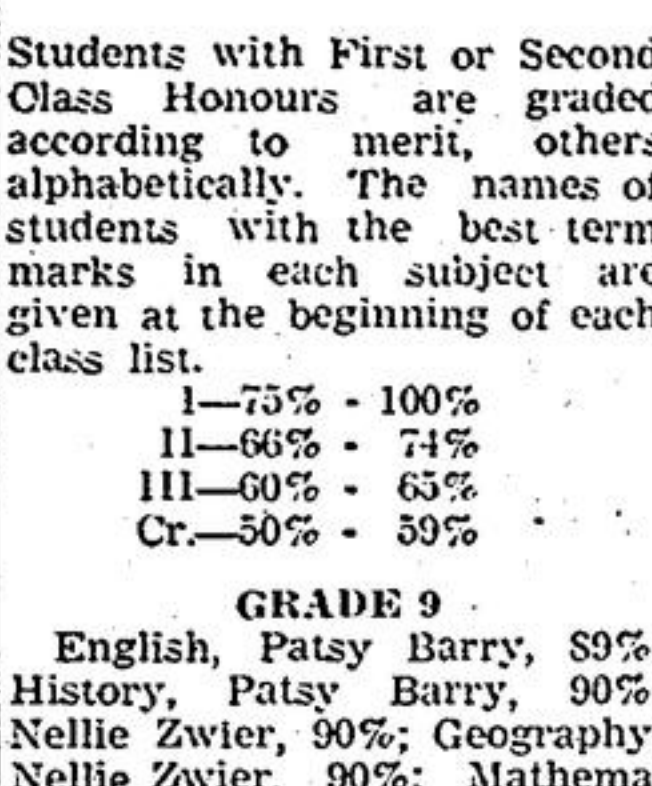
May Be Budgeting Into Bankruptcy - LeMasurier
