

**HONOURED AT CONVENTION**



On Friday afternoon at the United Missionary Church in Comley where the annual Ontario Conference was being held, Rev. C. N. Good of Kitchener was presented with a large anniversary cake baked by the Stouffville Bakery. The cake represented the 60th annual U.M.C. Conference that Rev. Good had attended since he entered the ministry in 1894. He was

also presented with a gift of money. Rev. Good was born in Iowa in 1869 and came to Canada at an early age. Following his entry into the ministry he held charges at Pt. Elgin, Breslau, Aylmer, Toronto, Markham and Kitchener. During the past years he has held a number of Convention offices. He retired in 1942 after fifty years of service.

**Chain Accident Sends Three To Hospital**

Three persons were hospitalized when two cars and a truck became involved in an accident on the Don Mills Road, south of Victoria Square on Sunday evening. The rear vehicle driven by Mrs. Helen Hughes of Toronto failed to stop when she approached a long line of congested traffic and crashed into a car in front, sending it crashing into a half-ton panel truck which had stopped. Mrs. Hughes suffered facial lacerations and chest injuries. Damage to her car amounted to \$350.

Mrs. Ann Notsch, a passenger in the other car, and a 3 month old baby, were also admitted to hospital suffering from shock and bruises. Damage to their vehicle amounted to \$800. The truck driven by John Crew, Eastdale Ave., Toronto, was not badly damaged. Constable Harvey Cox of the Markham Twp. Police investigated.

**11,000 Cattle Sprayed for Warble Flies**

A total of eleven thousand cattle were sprayed recently in Markham Township for warble flies. Of this number 8,000 were done by township sprayers while the balance received an application from the owners. It was revealed at the Markham Township Council meeting on Monday night that \$3,119.21 was collected from farmers for the work and \$22.50 in powder. In carrying out this disinfectant campaign Markham inspectors and township sprayers travelled 3,038 miles and spent 526 hours engaged in the work. The inspectors were Pat Hood, Albert Reesor and Nelson Boynton.
