Ps. 46:10; Isa. 40:30, 31; Luke 11:13; Phil. 4:6, 7; Heb. 4:14-16

THE LESSON AS A WHOLE

Approach to the Lesson
Prayer is a much-studied subject, but a little-practiced art...

Verse 10 - "... asketh receive... seeketh findeth... knocketh... opened."
Verse 11, 12 - "If a son shall ask bread... will he give him a stone... a fish... a serpent... an egg... a scorpion?"

Verse 13 - "... how much more shall our heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?"
