## Gormley W.I.

### Celebrates

### 25th Anniversary

The 25th anniversary of the  
Gormley Women's Institute  
organization was celebrated by  
a bus trip to Midland and Pen-  
tanguishene on Wednesday,  
July 27th.

Thirty-one ladies enjoyed  
this trip to Midland where Mrs.  
L. W. Zuefelt, a life member of  
the W.I., formerly of Richmond  
Hill and now residing in Mid-  
land, piloted the group to var-  
ious points of interest.

First visit was to Fort Stie  
Marie, burial place of Fathers  
Brebeuf and Lalemant, Jesuit  
Martyrs of the 17th century.  
These were only two of the  
Fathers who were burned at  
the stake by cruel Iroquois  
Indians in 1649. The Shrine
