



POTATO SEED LIST NOW AVAILABLE

A list has been prepared of potato growers in Ontario whose crops have met with official standards for Foundation and Certified seed and is now available from offices of Agricultural Representatives, from the Field Crops Branch of the Ont. Dept. of Agriculture, Toronto, or offices of Seed Potato Certification Service of the Canada Department of Agriculture. Offices are located at Ottawa, Guelph, Barrie, London and Winnipeg, Manitoba.

In 1956, 582 fields containing 1.828 acres were entered. Of this number 487 fields, or 1,419 acres were passed in Ontario. Katahdin, Sebago, Chippewa, Ir-ish Cobbler and Keswick are the most widely grown varieties, their popularity being in that order. Green Mountain continues to be grown in Northern and Eastern Ontario, but the Canso variety introduced a few years ago as blight resistant, is almost extinct. The Ontario variety is no longer accepted for certification because of its un-favorable characteristics from a quality standpoint.

Many Ontario growers give particular attention to production of seed potatoes, and have a reputation for producing seed stock that is second to none.

The Active Service Class held their Christmas Party last Tuesday night at the home of Mrs. Cecil Disney.


Friends are glad to hear that Miss Betty Gates came home from the Oshawa Hospital on Sunday restored to health again.
