Polio Shot Program Starts

The 1957 Polio inoculations began Monday, January 28, in the elementary and secondary schools of York County. At the present time, the first dose of the vaccine is being offered to pupils who had none previously, and this is to be followed by a second dose in approximately four weeks' time.

At the time the second dose visit is made to the schools, a third dose of vaccine will be offered to pupils who received their original two doses in the spring of 1956.

Providing sufficient supplies of polio vaccine are received as expected from the Provincial Department of Health, polio vaccination for preschool children, 6 months of age and over, will begin in April of this year when the inoculation of school-age children is completed. Pre-school centres will be established across the County. The location and dates for the centres will be announced in advance. Advance registration of pre-schoolers for Polio Immunization will not be required.
