### BULLFROG SEASON CLOSES OCT. 15

Bullfrogs may be taken in Ontario from July 1 to October 15-ten per day-but no one may be in possession of more than one day's legal catch at any

To take frogs on a commer clal basis, however, requires a \$5.00 licence which permits the licence holder to sell the frogs taken and to use artificial lights to take them at night. A sixby six foot dip net also may be used. No one has authority to take frogs with a spear. It takes three years for a

bullfrog to emerge from the tadpole stage and another three years to grow to parent size. So, small bullfrogs should be left unmolested so they may reach maturity and a decent size for eating, Ontario Department of Lands and Forests officials advise. There are no restrictions as

to the number of small green or leopard frogs that may be taken. These frogs are used in most cases as bait for the taking of fish.
