Verse 12-"For the seed shall be prosperous; the vine shall ... her increarse, ... the heavens . . . their dew; and I will sess all these . . . "The seed of peace" (Heb.) will be sown. The presence of God with His people will result not only in happibenediction to the people of the

Verse 13-". . as ye were a curse among the heathen, O ... "nations" (Heb). Note that the ten northern tribes (Israel) along with the 2 southern tribes (Judah) are here addressed. The "lost tribes" of the north will also be regathered. A sharp contrast: whereas the Hebrews had been a cuse to their captors. This changeless hope was a
