Markham Township Shares In Million \$ H. S. Budget

In order that Markham Township council might have a first-hand discussion on secondary matters, a deputation from the York Central District High School Board attended the recent council meeting. Those present were chairman Stewart Rumble from Headford, Mrs. James, Mr. Ashforth and Mr. Axelson.

Mr. Rumble told council that this year's school budget exceeded one million dollars and he frankly admitted that the sum was rather exceeding his vision. The actual figure is \$1,155,755 of which Markham Township pays 19.29% or a total of \$155,755. The School area now employs 83 teachers with an attendance

in three schools of 1800 students. They expect to open a fourth school in September at which time the teachers will number 102 and the students 2100. The gross cost per pupil is \$3.63 and the net \$1.18.

The Board members expressed alarm over the new sub-division in the southern corner of Markham Township, stated to ultimately have 600 homes. Mr. Rumble said that it appeared if this sub-division went ahead, it would mean a fifth school.

Reeve Clark stated that the taxpayers had become alarmed when they read of a ten mill increase in the press. This increase had been suggested at a previous meeting by deputy-

reeve Dean.

Clark Crisp stated that it was the practice of council to print all items in red on the tax bill over which they have no control. Mr. Rumble asked Reeve Clark if he had made any progress on his nomination suggestion of a Board of Education for Markham Twp. alone. The reeve replied that in view of the county setting up a Consultative Committee on Education, no further action had been taken to date.

It was suggested that if the Government was going to continue having children go to school until 16, then a vocational school to educate those who did not intend to continue on in

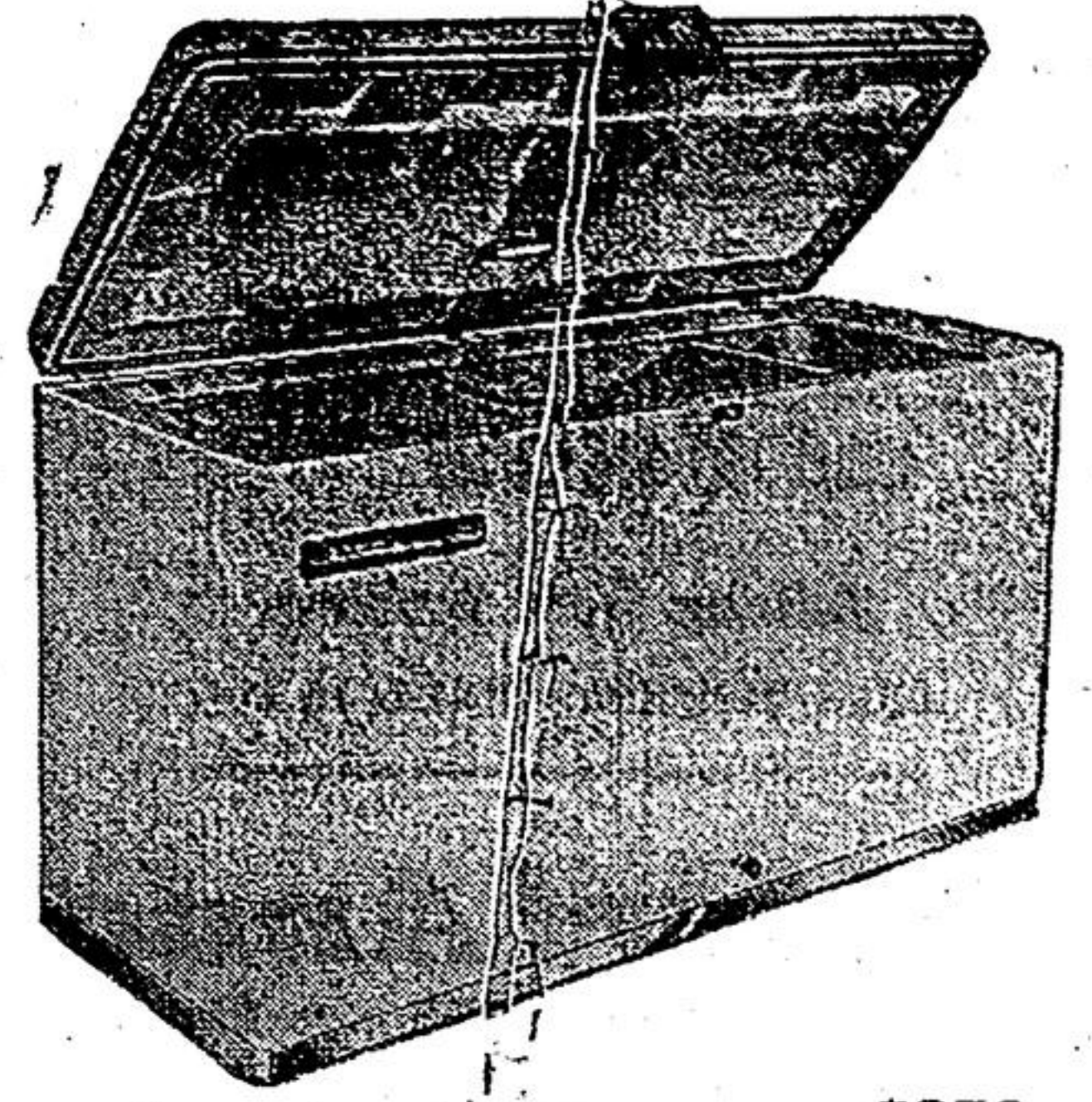
