Routine Business At Council

With only a quorum present Stouffville municipal council dealt only with routine business and accounts, at their regular meeting on Thursday evening. Deputy-reeve Ken Laushway and councillor Gar Lehman were absent.

A communication was received from Mr. Len Haylow suggesting that a sewer line be placed across Highway 47 prior to laying of the new and wider pavement, so that they might service his property and others, if and when they are annexed. Council members agreed that a lateral should go to the south side of the highway at either Winona Dr. or West Lawn Cres. before the highway work was completed and sewer committee chairman Lehman will be advised of their wishes on his return.

Two real estate appraisals will be made on the two park lots on Maytree Ave. which are to be disposed of by the municipality. The Dept. of Municipal Affairs requires these estimates before approval can be granted for the sale.

A draft plan of a small subdivision plan on Pt. of Block A Plan 410, on Manitoba St., has been approved. Restrictions will be placed on the height of basements, due to the land being primarily fill. The property is owned by Mr. Arthur Heaton.
