



Hammond | Crops Branch of the Ont. Dept. who passed away Feb. 6th, of Agriculture. Mr. Olan grew No pen can write, no tongue the Netted Gem variety, referred to in some areas as the Russett Burbank, and in other areas as the Idaho Baker. The Netted Gem potatoes, grown by Olan, tested 19.5 percent dry matter, with an estimated yield of 726 bushels per acre. In second place for the Province was Bill Lockie of Zephyr, Ontario County, with an estimated yield of 704 bushels per acre of

> Some 149 potato growers completed contests organized by County and District Branches of the Ontario Soil and Crop Improvement Association, in eight concentrated potato producing areas of the Province. Yields of over 500 bushels were attained by 54 growers with 15 reaching bushels while the average for Ontario in 1961 was 312 bushels per acre. This is more than 3 times the average per acre for the Province than was the case twenty years ago. Dry matter averaged 19.3 percent for 112 growers in the 1961 contests. This indicates that cooking and processing qualities for Ontario potatoes have also improved very favorably in recent years.
