### Former Councillor Charges Assessment Refund Delayed

Former, Pickering Township Councillor, Miss Violet Swan voiced criticism against the Assessment Department and the Commissioner in a verbal tirade before a regular meeting of Council on Monday night. Miss Swan charged that she had been granted a tax refund through the courts after registering an assessment appeal, but was still awaiting the refund. The amount of money is in excess of \$200.

Miss Swan called for a complete re-organization of the Assessment Department. “I have never been so humiliated as I have been in cases here,” she said. She charged that “hundreds of people” were too frightened to lodge assessment appeals.

Reeve Sherman Scott informed the complainant that he would look into the matter and a refund would be forthcoming immediately.


