**Question \$80,000 Increase in School Addition**  
 D. J. Ashforth, business administrator of York Central High School Board and William Masters, member of the board, appeared before Markham Township Council Monday to explain the increased demand for \$80,000 in the cost of the new school on the Vaughan side of Yonge St.  
 Mr. Ashforth stated that the board had previously found that in this fast-growing area it had been necessary to tear out walls to enlarge rooms after they had been completed. He said that while the school was only expected to have 500 to 600 students when it opened, the cafeteria was being built for 1200, and other rooms as well were being enlarged. The total cost of the school is now \$1,194,000.  
 The federal government will share in the expense as part of the school will be technical. Originally they paid the total cost but have since reduced this figure to 75%. The provincial grant will cover 60% of the balance.  
 Councillor Rumble, a former school board member, asked if the government would pay any portion of the \$80,000 increase, but the answer was no. He said he was in doubt about asking the taxpayer to bear the burden for those requiring a larger school in the future. However, council approved the request.
