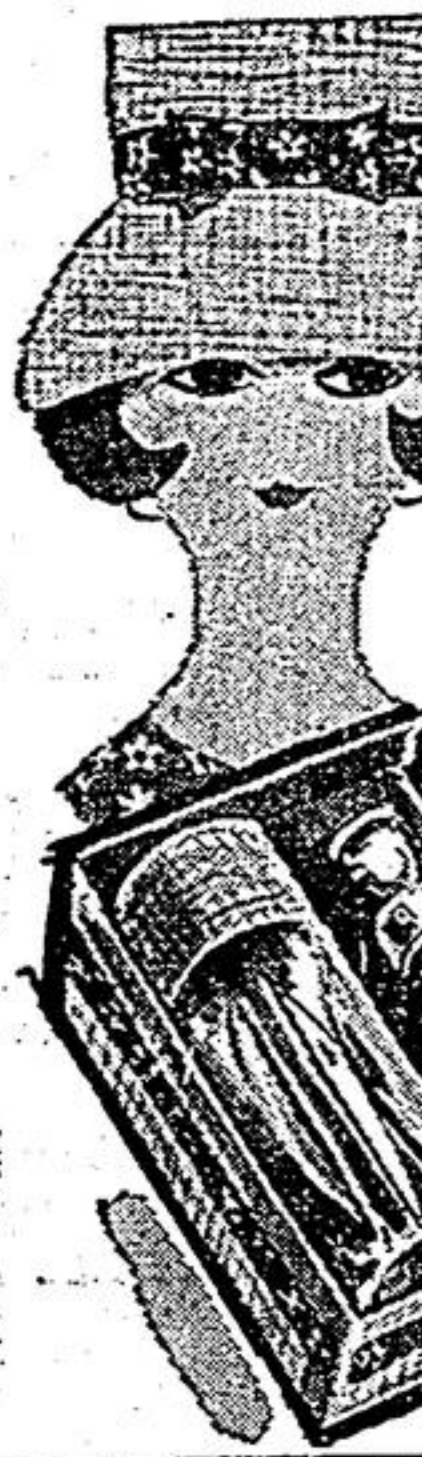

## Eight Speakers Compete for Hydro Trophy

Eight capable public speakers representing senior elementary public, separate and private schools in Halton, Peel, York (outside Metro Toronto) and Ontario counties will take part in a provincial semi-final (zone) oratorical contest on Thursday afternoon, (today) April 4th, at Bayview Heights Public School, Liverpool Road area, Pickering Township, for the honor of representing schools in these four counties on April 15 in the 1963 provincial final public speaking contest.

The eight top orators, who will take part in the provincial semi-final contest, are the district finalists for the four counties and represent some 98,000 elementary students who have taken part in oratorical competitions in county public, private and separate schools in the past few months. A winner will be selected in this zone (provincial semi-final) contest to enter the 1963 province-wide final public speaking contest for senior elementary students to be held on Monday, April 15, during the Ontario Educational Association convention in Toronto at the King Edward-Sheraton Hotel. All the elementary school zone winners of the province, representing more than a million students will compete in that final oratorical contest.

The most important county

public speaking event of the year, the Thursday, April 4th provincial semi-final contest in Pickering Township, is co-sponsored by the Ontario Educational Association, the Ontario Trustees and Ratepayers' Association and the Ontario Municipal Electric Association (Municipal Hydro Commissioners). The provincial final contest is co-sponsored by Ontario Hydro.

An attractive engraved silver Hydro cup donated by the Ont. Municipal Electric Assoc. will be presented to the winner of the provincial semi-final contest in Pickering Twp. on April 4th. All the runners-up will receive valuable book prizes.

This competition at Bayview Heights Public School, Pickering Twp., will start at 2 p.m. and the judges' decision is expected about 3:15 p.m. Hydro Commissioners from Pickering Public Utilities Commission and Ajax Hydro, who are members of the Ontario Municipal Electric Association, will present the silver Hydro cup and the book prizes to the winner and the runners-up.

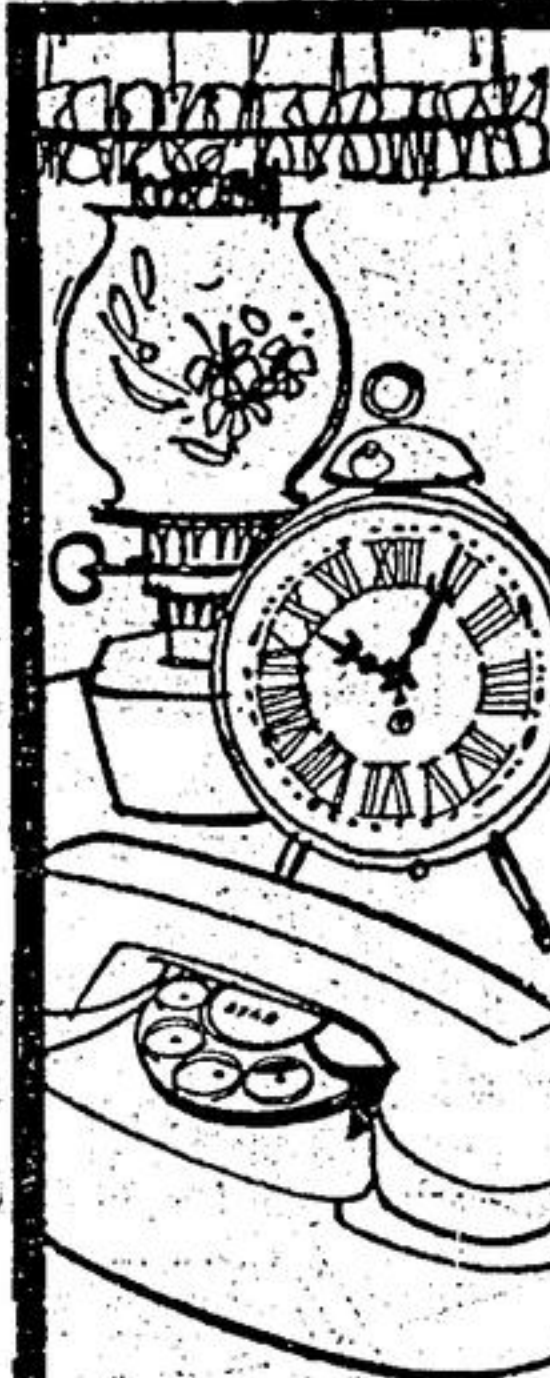
## Ringwood Cow Goes to Brazil
