Calves Average \$152 At Oakville Sale

The Annual All-Breed Calf Sale held at Hays Farms of Oakville saw 216 calves of seven breeds go through the ring on April 15th. This sale is intended primarily to provide a supply of high class calves that 4-H boys and girls can buy at reasonable prices. It also serves as a source for the purchase of foundation stock by new breeders and buyers in other countries while a few of the top go to well established Canadian herds.

The 216 calves sold for a total of \$32,890 a general average of \$152 each. There were 183 Holsteins that sold for \$31,230, an average of \$159 each; 11 Jerseys that averaged \$110; 6 Guernseys that averaged \$86; 4 Ayrshires that averaged \$77. The twelve beef calves averaged \$138 consisting of 4 Angus, 7 Herefords and 1 Shorthorn.

Twenty-five of the Holstein calves brought over \$200 each, with five of them topping the

\$300 mark and one bringing the highest price of \$400. This was the August 1962 calf of Master Sovereign Daisy, consigned by Master Feeds Farms, Thornhill, Ontario and bought by Glenatton Farms, Alliston, Ont. She is a daughter of the "Excellent" sire, Roeland Reflection Sovereign and her dam is classified "Very Good."

Of the 66 head sold for export, 39 went to Mexico, 9 to Puerto Rico and 2 to the United States while Hays Farms bought 16 head for export to unnamed Latin American buyers. The largest Mexican buyer was Miguel Miquelotrena of Tulancingo, who secured 35 head.

Other high prices paid included: \$320 paid by J.M. Fraser, Streetsville, Ontario to Eaton Hall Farms, King, Ontario; \$275 paid by C.H. Boake, Maple, Ont. paid to Elmercote Farms, Beaverton, Ont.; \$260 paid by E.Y. Morwick, Jerseyville, Ontario to

U. M. Church Raises Over \$9,000 In Missionary Drive

At the close of the Sunday evening service at the Stouffville United Missionary Church, climaxing a week-long series of meetings, a total of over \$9,000 had been raised for the missionary work of the church. Rev. Arthur Walsh announced the actual total money received as \$9,249.00 including offerings received through the W.M.S. and the Sunday School.

Last year's goal was \$8,000. The new goal was set because of a report coming from the annual meeting of the United

Missionary Society Board to the effect that there are young people waiting to go to the mission field with not enough funds to make their going possible. Speaking during the convention were Richard Reilly, Foreign Secretary of the U.M.S., John Hamilton of India, Mrs. Edna Brubacher of Nigeria and Russell Sloat, Vice Supt. of the African Field. Mrs. Grant Sloss, who, with her husband, has served in Nigeria, addressed the congregation in the closing service.

The Women's Missionary Society accepted responsibility for arranging and conducting the convention service of Friday night.

Legislation Would Protect Farmers From Hunters

New legislation to provide compensation for damage to property by hunters was introduced by Agriculture Minister, Wm. A. Stewart last week. This follows earlier stiffening of penalties under the Ontario Game and Fisheries Act which should provide greater protection for farmers against irresponsible hunters.

This new act makes it possible for persons who have livestock killed or injured or property damaged, to apply to the Minister of Agriculture for compensation. The Minister may then take action against the persons responsible to recover payments to farmers for damages.

Mr. Stewart said he had been concerned for some time about damage caused by some hunters and he had been informed that responsible hunters were also concerned. Farmers should not be asked to be responsible for damages and this act, the Minister felt would relieve them. "This legislation," he said, "will make it possible for the Crown to recover costs, and this along with stiffer penalties, should act as a deterrent to those who think they can ignore the property rights of farm people."

Compensation payments are limited to the market value of the livestock or property. The act stipulates that the government can appoint valuers to appraise the injury or damage.

Total revenues collected from all sources by Markham Twp. Council in 1962 amounted to \$2,054,000.00. The net result of the year's operation was a deficit of \$665.00.

Reeve Dean commented that this was a close figure considering the large amount of money dealt with. He said that if the subsidized amount from the government on park land purchased was taken into account the township would have shown a surplus of \$15,000.
