Poultry Producers to Vote On Egg Marketing Plan

Ontario Poultry Producers will have the privilege of voting on an egg marketing plan. This information was revealed recently to the directors of Ontario County Federation of Agriculture at their regular meeting held at Brock Township Hall in Sunderland.

Mr. Bob Meek of Sandford, one of the County's most interesting and successful egg producer's and Mr. Les Meyers, fieldman for the Ontario City Federation of Agriculture attended the Poultry Producers' annual meeting at the Royal York Hotel, Toronto on April 3rd. The suggested date for the vote is in October.

The executive of the Poultry Producers feel that they have a proposal that will (a), meet with the approval of the producers, (b), comply with the wishes of the Ontario Farm Products Marketing Board, (c), correct the marketing abuses and wild price fluctuations.

It is expected that if the producers of eggs vote in favour of a marketing plan, an auction system, similar to that introduced by the Hog Producers, will be used.
