TIPS

ON PREPARING HOUSING FOR PULLETS

Here's a convenient checklist of things you should do before housing pullets:

1. Clean out old litter — right down to floor.
2. Scrape off all clinging droppings; sweep down cobwebs and dust on walls, ceilings, etc.
3. Now is the time to make all repairs that are needed.

FARM REPORT

A. A. Wall, Agricultural Representative, York County.

I have had a lot of calls this week from farmers with problems in their oat crop. Many fields look yellow and growth is stunted. The most likely cause of this trouble is a disease called Barley Yellow Dwarf Virus. The disease was first found in barley but it is just as common in oats.

The yellowing starts on the edges of the leaves, and moves downward. Usually, the leaves are stiffer and more erect than normal, and are often twisted. The root is stunted just as badly as the top, and if the infection is severe, the plant will never head out.

The disease is spread by aphids. The whole field may be affected evenly, but more often the most severe damage is in patches. Yield losses from the disease range from 25% to 75%. There is no cure for Barley Yellow Dwarf. Sprays to kill the aphids carrying the disease, have been tried with only fair success.

too, and the symptoms are very similar to Yellow Dwarf. Nematode damage however, is likely to be more patchy and the effect on the crop will be more gradual. Another difference is that nematodes usually only occur on lighter soils.

Still another problem that has shown up with oats this year, is the damage from Atrazine residue. The Atrazine sprayed on corn last year has, on some farms, left enough residue to affect oats. On one farm, the crop has been lost completely. Affected oats will germinate and appear normal for the first two or three inches of growth. The leaves then bleach quickly, become white in appearance, and the plant dies. Usually residue damage only shows up where the sprayer has overlapped.

To reduce the risk, the rate for Atrazine should be kept low, if oats are to follow corn. Our recommendation is for 2 to 4 lbs. per acre, but if oats are being grown the year after corn, I suggest using only 2 lbs. per acre.

NEW IDEA HOME DECORATIONS

A popular summer project for many homeowners is the construction of a wood deck, a desirable addition to older homes or new.

A modern wood deck will give you outdoor living space where you want or need it. With a bit of help and advice from an established lumber dealer, the home handyman will find a wood deck relatively simple to assemble. Some dealers can provide detailed plans for the project.

The design shown could be lengthened to serve two areas of the home, through sliding glass doors or French windows. It could also be shortened to make a sun deck off a bedroom.

For a deck span of up to 12 feet, use a 4" x 8" girder and two 4" x 4" posts. For lengths above 12 feet, consult your building-materials dealer. He'll also recommend that the lumber you use be either durable hardwood or preservative-treated.
