Pulpwood Operations Get Under Way

Pulpwood cutting operations in Agreement Forests in the Lake Simcoe District will be commencing shortly. A quota of 2015 cords has been allocated to the District for the 1963-64 season. Of this, some 1450 cords, made up chiefly of Red Pine, with smaller amounts of Jack, White and Scotch Pine, are being sold as "stumpage wood". This means that the purchaser, Ontario Paper Company, buys the wood on a per cord basis, as it stands in the plantations.

The balance, 1565 cords, also predominantly Red Pine, will be produced, on contract, by local woodworkers, and sold to the company at so much per cord peeled at the roadside. The pulpwood is being produced in York, Ontario, Dufferin and Simcoe counties, the latter supplying 2200 cords of the total quantity. Most of the cuts will be in the form of second thinning. This means that the plantations are approximately 35 years old and have been thinned once before, probably about 10 years ago.

The thinning will remove about 25% of the volume of the stand and return some eight cords per acre.

All trees are marked by trained Department of Lands and Forest rangers who ensure that the "crop" or high quality trees are left to grow to maturity.

Woods operations will be starting right away, with the expectation the quota will be completed by the middle of January.

All children are invited to attend the Happy Hour meeting in the Sunday School at 1:30 p.m. on Sat., Dec. 7th.

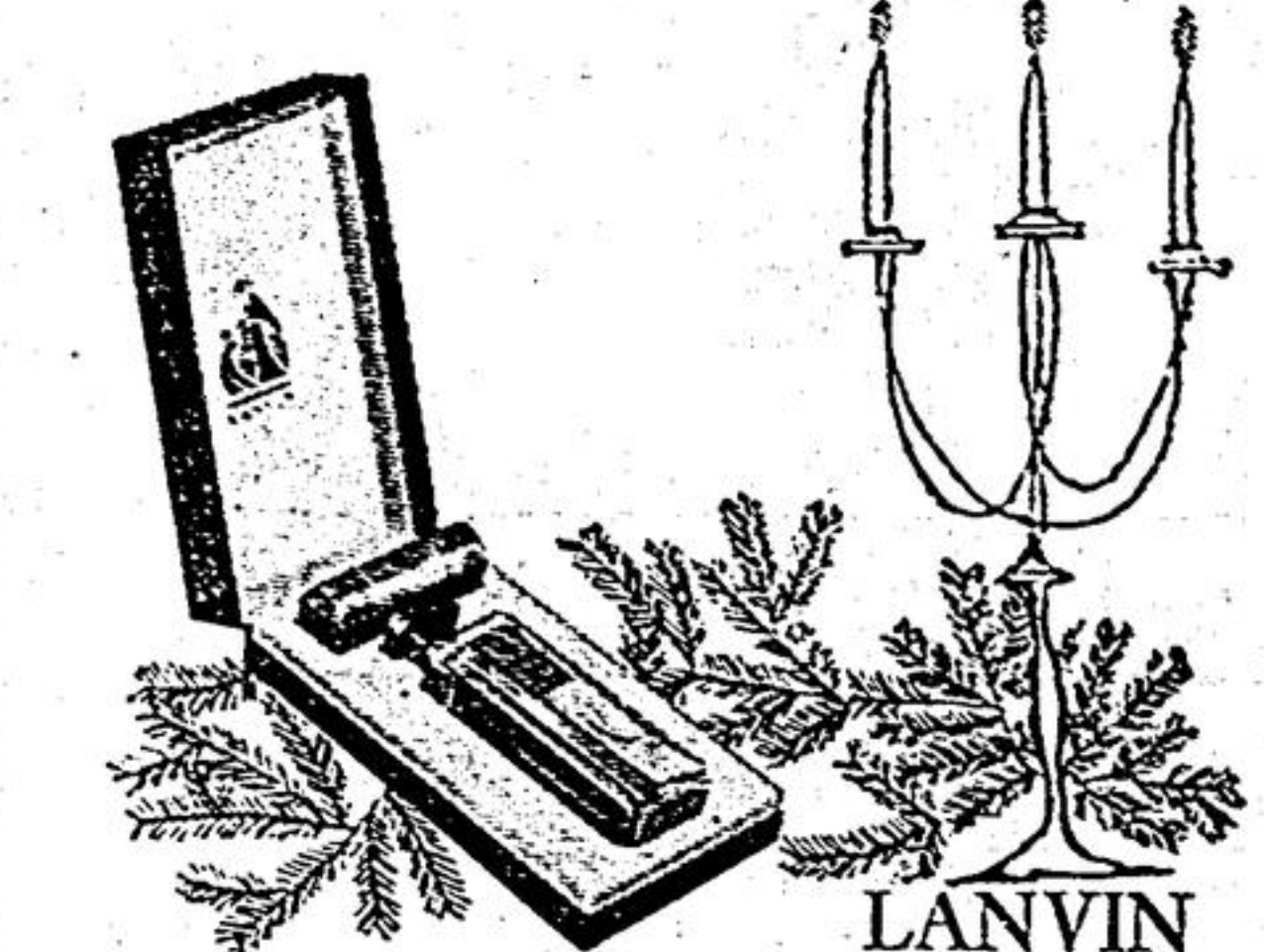
Protect Your Trees From Rabbit Damage

Rabbits, numerous in many Ontario areas, cause considerable damage in orchards and gardens during winter by eating the bark of trees and shrubs. They also nip off buds and thin branches anywhere within reach.

Horticulturists with the Ontario Department of Agriculture suggest using either mechanical or chemical repellents to protect trees and shrubs from rabbits. The whole area may be enclosed by a chicken wire fence, or if the trees are few in number it may be easier to surround each individual tree with chicken wire.

There are chemical repellents on the market which have been used successfully. Always follow the directions exactly as they are printed on the container. Most repellents are poisonous and require safe use and storage.

Aluminum foil or tar paper wrapped around the tree, and then enclosed with chicken wire has been found to be effective against mice damage as well as rabbit damage.
