Tree-Saver In Use By D.H.O

Highways planted 77,882 trees and shrubs along Ontario's with black, well washed hair Highways, the Department announced this week in a report on tree planting operations. Since the Fall of 1959, when the Department acquired its "tree-saver", a 16-ton vehicle, capable of lifting, transporting and re-planting trees up to 30 feet in height, this versatile machine has transplanted 5,616 large trees, many of which would otherwise have had to

be destroyed. Along the 17-mile section of Highway 401 in Metropolitan Toronto which is being widened to 12 lanes, the tree saver has been used to move and replant 1,600 trees since reconstruction of the highway was started a little over a year ago.


