Would Equalize License Fees

Reeve Haggart of Richmond Hill and Deputy-reeve Laushway of Stouffville combined in county council last week to introduce a move to have all license fees, such as transient traders, equalized in all municipalities in the county. The Stouffville representative said he didn't think it was right that a man could peddle our town for \$25 and when he moved over the border the rate was double this amount.

The question did not go to a vote and was tabled to be introduced at a later date.

A resolution by Richmond Hill was supported to the effect that the government should be asked to pay their grants in full at the time of building a school. The vote on this subject was unanimous.

TRAFFIC HEAVY ON BLOOMINGTON ROAD

Whitchurch Township council who have been hard-pressed for some years to keep the side-roads running east and west through Bloomington under repair, have recently had a road traffic count done on the road running from Highway 48 east to Bloomington.

In a twenty-four hour period the number of vehicles travelling this mile and a quarter was 1,078. The count was taken by the Toronto & York Road Commission. Road Supt. commented at Monday's council meeting when the figure was revealed that it would have been even heavier if taken east of the 9th concession as a large number of trucks use the 9th concession and then swing east.

Father-Son Bus. Arrang.

In father and son business planning all three types of credit may be used, long term, intermediate term and short term. Fathers and sons should consider the situations pointed out below, advises A. C. Robertson of the Department of Agricultural Economics, Ontario Agricultural College, Guelph.

Credit May Help
The father and his son to organize a unit large enough to support two families.

To establish a paying project for the son where they were unable to start a project before.

By the wise use of credit parents may be able to have the son buy into the farm. In bargaining for credit, whether long term (mortgage), intermediate or short, a father who has assets and a son possessing youth and ability may, by the partnership, be able to obtain better interest rates and repayment conditions.

Credit May Hinder
By obligating the father for

larger amounts and a longer time than he feels he should be obligated at his present time of life. The son could be tied to a credit arrangement that is difficult to rearrange or discharge if harmony between the households broke down.
