We understood at the time ters that had to be disposed of. Since then, however, he has brought forward the flag issue and has indicated that it will be debated prior to any of these important government measures.

The flag debate can naturally be expected to carry on for some time as every Member of Parliament, or most, would like to express his opinion on this very important matter. This would in no sense mean that a filibuster would be undertaken. An opportunity must, of course, be provided for Members of Parliament, who wish, to state their position. As a result, we have now relegated important legislation as a secondary consideration to the flag issue.

The Pension Plan has been shelved temporarily as some of the Provinces have not given their consent to amending the Constitution in order to provide survival benefits under this Plan. The Province of Quebec has indicated that it will be nec essary for them to have aprpoval in their legislature for such an amendment. This may take some weeks as no doubt the members of that legislature may wish to discuss this matter in some detail.


