

This is an increase their recently published report. the Economic Council of Canada recommended that we hold any increase in the cost of liv-This increase is .7 percentage points above the recommendation and the Government was immediately asked about this increase. The reply by the Minister of Finance was that the Government is doing its best to encourage everybody to keep down the cost of production and they are watching the situation carefully. This answer did not satisfy the Members and suggestions were made that the Government remove the 11% sales tax, which would help the situation a great deal. In the past year the Government imposed an 11% sales tax on building materials and production machinery. This naturally increased costs in both fields of activity and has contributed to the cost of living rise.

The B and B Commission is in trouble again.
