

If the plant is growing too tall, pinch the new growth in early July. This will allow time for new shoots to develop and flower buds to set. To promote bud setting, move the plant to full light in early August. Stop feeding by September 1, and move it into a cool, dark storage area before frost. Although it requires little water in storage at 45 degrees F. it should be kept moist. The foliage will drop off while in storage and should be removed to prevent mildew.

For Easter bloom remove the plant from storage after Christmas and place in a temperature of 60 degrees F.
