Addition Planned for Unionville Public School Not To Exceed \$80,000

Board members of TSA #2, Markham, plan a 4-room addition to the Unionville Public School to be ready for occupancy next September.

Sketch plans from architects Hicks and McLean, Jackson and Ypes, and W. W. Rankin have been examined over the past few weeks, and the board agreed at their meeting of April 13 to hire Hicks and Associates.

The addition is to be built out of current funds, and last week the board passed a recommendation of committee setting \$80,000 as the maximum expenditure, complete with furniture.

New staff applications have been reviewed, and teachers engaged for the school year 1965-66 are Lorraine Livingston, Gillian Levingbird, and Nancy Brunwell.

Supervisors include Jack Nemchin, Librarian, who will serve in TSA #1 and TSA #2 at a salary of \$6,700 plus mileage.

The interviewing committee included Inspector Maynard Hallman, Mrs. Pat Kimbark, one principal and one grade teacher, plus board members.

A new salary schedule has been agreed on, raising the one which was decided on earlier to meet the Metro rate.

Monthly reports from each school were considered, and maintenance appears to be a puzzling problem.

At #5 school, Buttonville, Principal Howard Atkinson reported his school in excellent shape, but at Mount Joy the school grounds are muddy.

Insurance coverage was discussed and Mrs. Toogood asked for agents to come to a board meeting to discuss the matter.

It was agreed to invite Gord Birkett, Ken Laushway, Jack Carson and Keith Brown to come to a meeting on the evening of April 27 to explain their companies' policies.

Renovate Lawns In Spring

After the ravages of a long, hard winter, lawns need extra care in the spring.

To maintain fertility and to ensure good growth of established turf, fertilizer should be applied as soon as possible.

Special turf fertilizers such as 41-73, 12-6-6 or 6-10-4 are the most suitable for lawns.

The first figure of the formula represents the percentage nitrogen present in the lawn.

Top-dressing is beneficial where the topsoil is shallow or low in fertility.

Prune Roses In The Spring

Roses, particularly the hybrid teas, should be pruned each spring before the bushes leaf out.

Each plant should be considered individually and pruned according to its habit and amount of growth.

Do not prune the plants too severely; light pruning results in larger plants with more blooms.

First cut back all the dead wood, weak growths, and remove all crossing branches.

This should leave five or six strong growths which may be shortened according to their growth to give a uniform appearance.

To obtain as many blooms as possible, the floribunda-type roses should be pruned lightly and similarly to hybrid teas.

Dwarf polyanthas need only have dead wood removed in the spring.
