The men's quintette and pianist Mrs. D. Clark were recipients of music books "Sacred

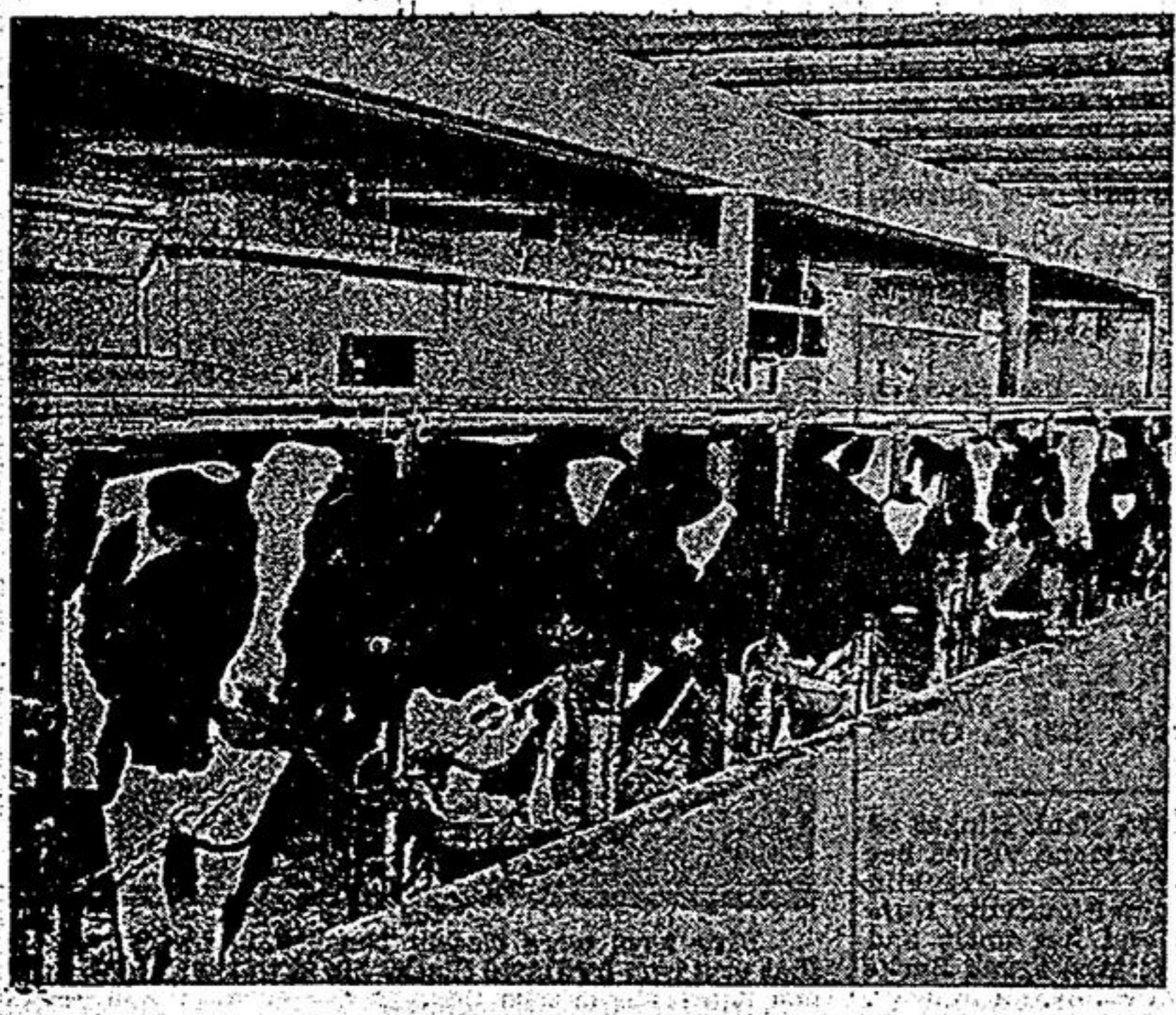
songs and solos" donated by Miss Norah Stapleton, Main St., Stouffville. Mr. Earl Davis made the presentation on Sunday.
