**PLANT BULBS NOW FOR SPRING SPLENDOR**

One of spring's most pleasing sights is masses of tulips and daffodils. Bulbs should be planted now for spring bloom, advise horticulturists with the Ontario Department of Agriculture. Here are a few hints on planting that should lead to success.

As a general rule, bulbs succeed best on fertile, sandy loam soils, but they tolerate a wide range of soil conditions provided drainage is adequate. Dig the soil well in advance of planting and add organic matter to improve the physical condition and fertility of the soil. Apply a complete garden fertilizer such as 5-20-20 or one of similar analysis at the rate of two to three pound per 100 square feet.

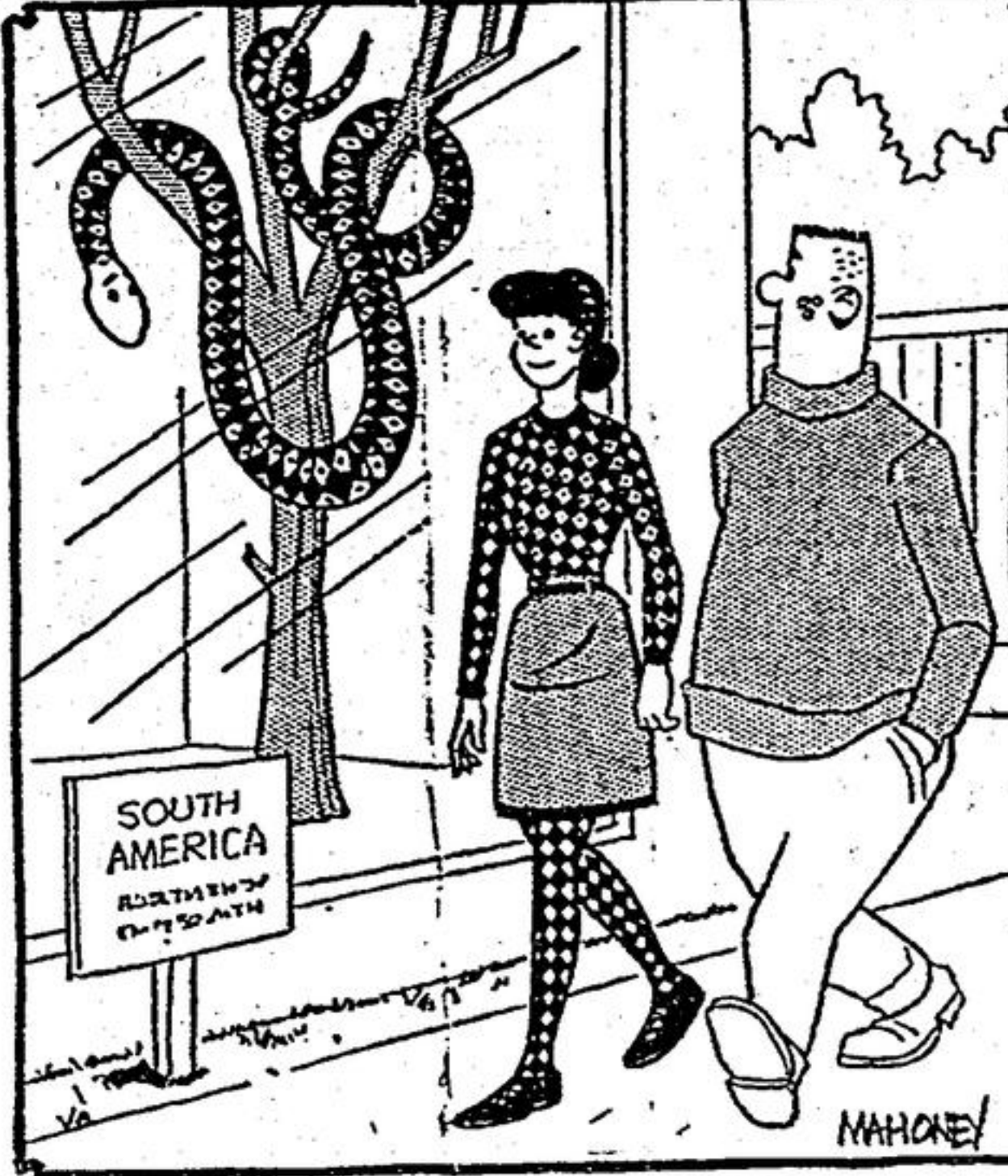
The importance of buying first grade bulbs from a reliable source cannot be overstressed. Bargain bulbs are generally poor in quality and small in size; they may carry disease or lack flower buds and thus give a poor display, or fail completely.

Spring flowering bulbs should be planted in early fall or as soon as they are received. This ensures better root systems which means a better show in the spring.

Planting depth is important! A general rule to follow is to cover the bulb with about twice its own depth of soil; thus a bulb that is one inch from base to apex should be covered with two inches of soil. Bulbs should be planted slightly deeper in light, sandy soils than in those of heavier texture. Tulips bulbs may be planted reasonably close together — three to four inches apart when individual clumps are being arranged in a border.

There are several methods commonly used in planting. The most common method is to dig holes with a trowel and to plant each bulb individually. Therefore, in formal beds the rows must be marked carefully so that the bulbs come up evenly. Information on growing all types of bulbs suited to Ontario

**"Hydro Special" Electric Blanket Bonus With Dryer**

A free electric blanket will be offered with every new electric clothes dryer sold as part of the "Hydro Special" campaign in Ontario from Oct. 2 to Nov. 20.

The province-wide promotion of electric clothes dryers is being supported jointly by appliance dealers and electrical utilities. Campaign displays of electric dryers in participating appliance stores and electrical utility offices will be identified by the "Hydro Special" theme.

The promotion is also tied in with the Canada-wide "Walk Through Washday" campaign by the Canadian Appliance Manufacturers Association during the same seven-week period.

Participating appliance dealers will have samples of the bonus electric-blanket on display during the campaign period. The floral-print blanket is double-bed size with a single control.

Electric clothes dryers and electric blankets will be included in Ontario Hydro's mobile display coach, and in exhibits at fall fairs and exhibitions. Hydro's home economists will feature the care and use of dryers and electric blankets in their presentations.
