Increase In Postal Rate To Other Countries

Effective 1st January 1966, the surface rates of Postage to other countries will be as follows:

Letters
5c for the first oz. and 3c for each additional oz. to Gr. Britain and the Commonwealth, Republic of Ireland, United States and its territories and possessions, other countries of North, Central and South America, the West Indies, France and Spain.

Post Cards
4c each to all countries to which the letter rate of 5c and 3c applies, 6c each to all other countries.

Printed Matter (Except Second Class Matter)
3c for the first 2 oz. and 1c for each additional 2 oz. to the United States, its territories and possessions, and other countries of North, Central and South America, the West Indies and Spain.

Air Mail
In addition a uniform air mail rate of 10c will be introduced for single post cards to all countries except the United States, and its territories and possessions, to which the rate will remain at 8c. The 10c rate will also apply to single post cards sent by air mail to members of the Canadian Forces, their dependents and civilians attached to the Military served through a C.F.P.O.

Parcel Post
The Canada Post Office is adopting a system providing for one set of rates on a four step weight scale, covering parcels up to and including 22 lb. in weight to a group of countries in each of three world zones. Further information on these new rates will be furnished later on. The rates to United States remain unchanged.

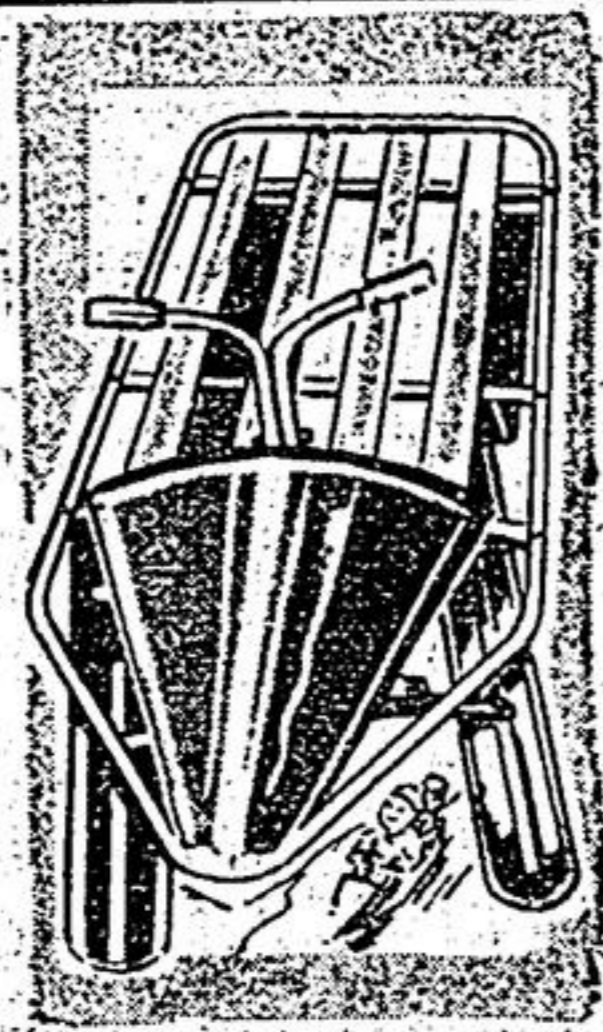

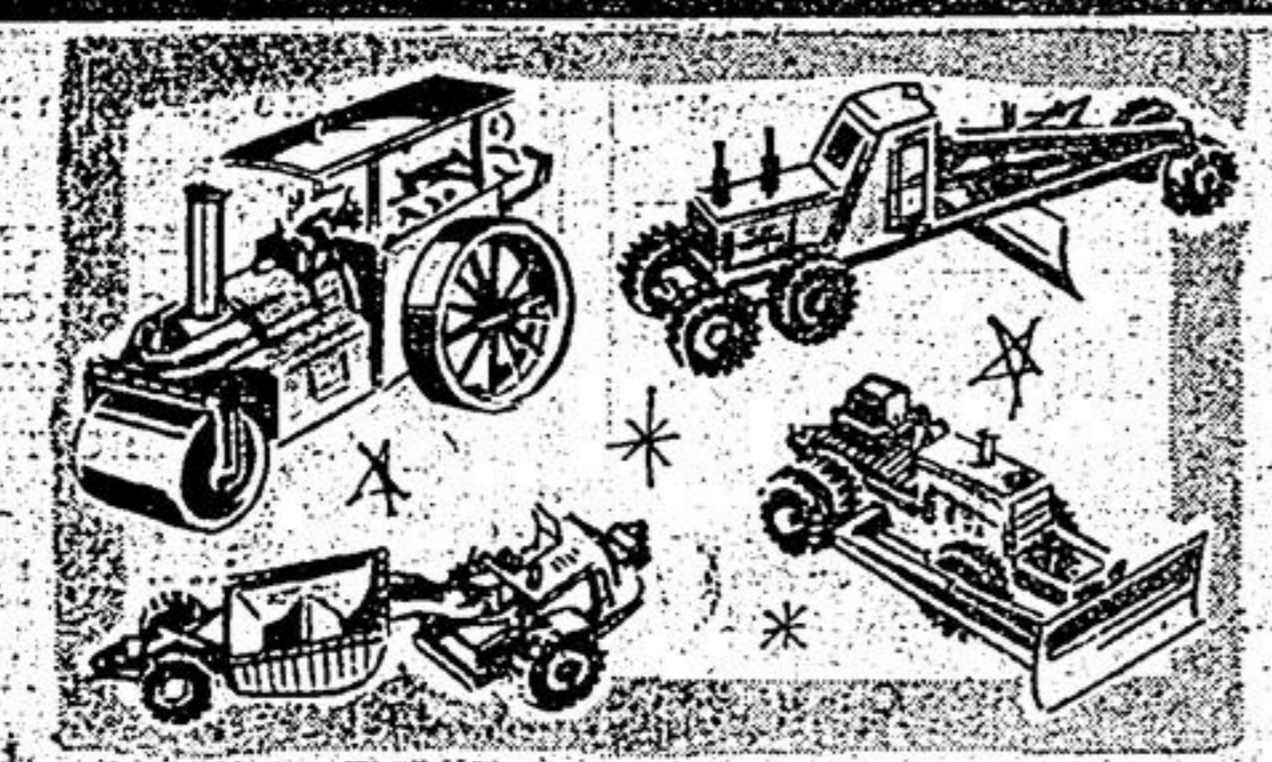
