Our Centennial Year Will Be Good For Canadians

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The new year will be a favorable one for Canada; the economy will be boosted and there will be a continued development of heavy industry. There may also be proposals for federation with the United States in the near future and trading between the two countries will be certainly intensified.

Those are some of the predictions that Old Moore's Almanac gives for Canada in its Centennial Year.

Nuclear developments in producing electrical power that will help to hold rising prices steady are forecast for March and we are told that it is "very likely" that a conference will be called to discuss the transition of the Commonwealth into a confederation of autonomous states. This will be to prevent a further breakaway of Commonwealth members.

April will bring a switch of public opinion in the United States from the Democrats to the Republicans along with the month's perennial showers. Continued agitation in the United States will compel it to withdraw forces from some areas and start a reappraisal of manpower usage.

May foresees the loss of a large oil tanker at sea and the crossing of the Indian border by Chinese troops.

In June the United States will circle the moon with a manned space probe in preparation for a manned space landing.

Freak weather conditions in August will cause air and sea disasters around the world and in September it is predicted that the Democrats will become low men on the political totem pole, with a strong swing of public opinion to the Republicans.

In October there will be a political crisis in Canada and outbreaks of violence around the world. There will also be the threat of the overthrow of Formosa.


There'll be a shuffle in the Kremlin leadership in November and in December there will be a dock strike in New York. People will generally be in high hopes of peace in the final months of 1967, and Christmas spending will reach a high level.

And that, according to the seers of Old Moore's, is the way the world will look tomorrow — and the next day. But don't cancel your newspaper subscription, just because you've had a glimpse into the future. Almanacs have been wrong.


