## Four-Year Grads Can Now Enter Nursing

STOUFFVILLE — The Ontario Hospital Association today welcomed changes in legislation which will open the doors of nursing schools for the first time to graduates from the Ontario Department of Education's 4-year high school program.

Up to now, the minimum qualification for entry into nursing has been Grade 12 of the regular five-year course with certain required science subjects. The new regulation under the province's Nurse Act, as published in the latest Ontario Gazette, now widens the entrance requirement to include Grade 12 graduates from either the four or five year streams. However, students from the four year program will be required to have Grade 10 mathematics as well as the necessary science subjects.

The change was recommended to the Minister of Health by the College of Nurses of Ontario, which administers the Nurse Act.

"This is a welcome and necessary move," said R. Alan Hay, Executive Director of the Ontario Hospital in terms of nursing recruitment probably would

Association today. "Our need for registered nurses is so great that it is unrealistic to deny the opportunity to thousands of capable young people simply because they prefer the four-year course. By insisting on certain required subjects I think we can be sure that the educational calibre of our nursing students will be safeguarded."

Mr. Hay anticipated that the benefits of this move will not be felt for a year or two. "We assume that schools of nursing across the province are already mostly enrolled for the new classes commencing next month. However, as new nursing schools are established and others expand in the years ahead under the impetus of the province's 'action program,' more and more students will have the opportunity to enter the profession."
