# School Teacher 30 Years

VICTORIA SQUARE — A long-time, respected resident of Victoria Square passed away in the person of Louis L. Nichols, Thursday, Sept. 28, 1967.  
Mr. Nichols was born April, 1883, at Victoria Square, the oldest of a family of four of Wm. Franklin Nichols and Mary Ann Lundy. He lived his entire life in this community. His last residence was on the farm at lot 24, where his son Cecil now lives, a farm which had been in the family for sixty years.  
Mr. Nichols graduated from the Toronto Normal School in 1905, and spent more than 30 years teaching in three neighboring schools, S.S. No. 4; S.S. No. 5; and S.S. No. 7, Markham. Along with his teaching career he was a successful farmer.  
Mr. Nichols was an ar-

dent church worker, and served as elder and steward at Victoria Square. For many years he taught the Adult Bible Class in the Sunday school, and for a period was the superintendent.  
Mr. Nichols and Hattie Wellman were united in marriage in June, 1907, by Rev. Wesley Dean. They resided for a short time at Victoria Square with the groom's parents, then moved one lot north. In 1914, they took up residence at lot 24. Mr. and Mrs. Nichols celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in June 1957. Mrs. Nichols predeceased him in December 1960.  
He is survived by his three children, Cecil of Victoria Square, Vera of Toronto, and Reva (Mrs. Douglas Gee) of R.R. 2, Gormley, also 14 grandchildren, and 12 great grandchildren.

## How To Tell A Good Used Car From A Bad One?

Estimating the condition of a used car is a job that requires an expert. But any motorist with ordinary car sense can spot some of the more obvious faults that show up in a brief inspection.

Wear on mats, pedal pads and upholstery give a good indication of mileage and are a better guide than the speedometer. Normal use for a car is 12,000 miles per year though mileage in excess of this is not necessarily a bad sign if the car has been well cared for.

Look along the fender in a good light for signs of previous heavy body damage. Body damage becomes important when a collision is sufficient to twist a car's frame. A car will sometimes never operate properly after that, though minor collision damage is unimportant.

While the engine is warmed up and idling, press lightly on the accelerator. Uneven sounds, heavy clicking or knocking can mean future trouble. This is a good time to check for worn rings. Several heavy pumps on the gas will send blue smoke (from burning oil) out of the exhaust pipe if there is trouble brewing.

A dealer who reconditions and stands behind his product is your best guarantee. But failing that it would be wise to have a mechanic check the car if it looks good but you're still doubtful.
