MARKHAM — A representative for cable television addressed a meeting of Markham Village Council, Monday, but failed to gain any assurance from the members that they would approve the scheme.

Total damage, including a hydro pole, snapped off by the impact, was estimated at \$1,200.



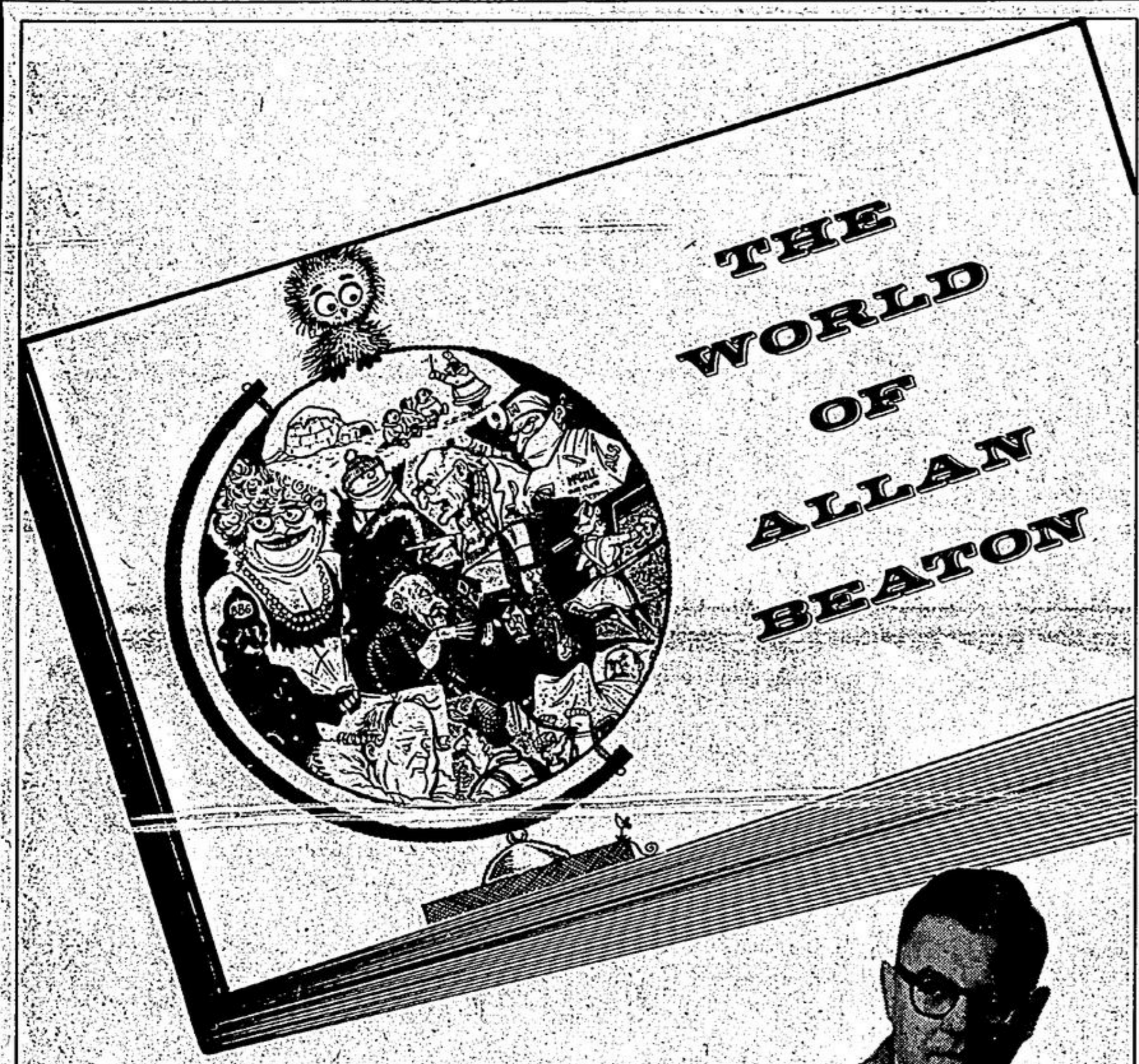

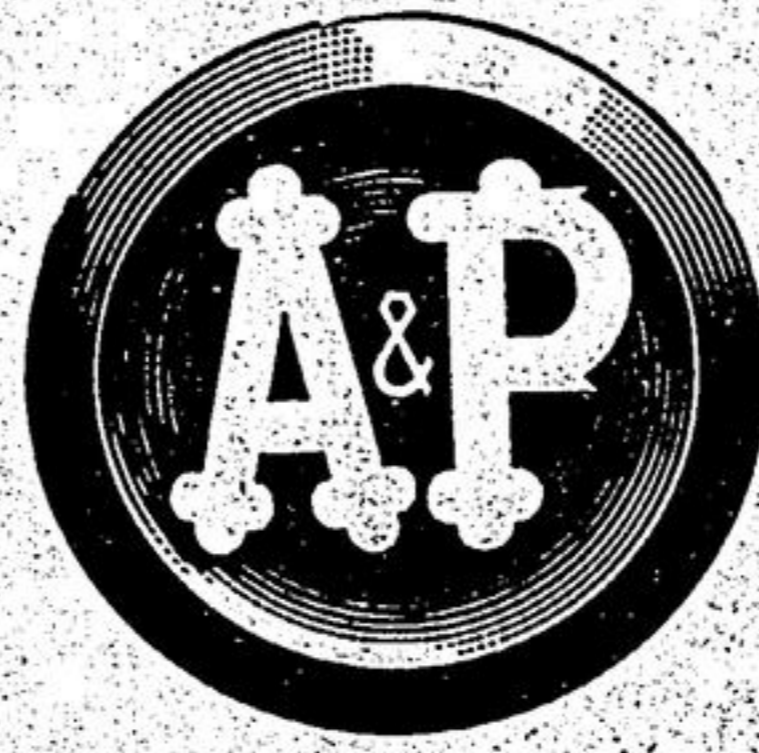
