Favors Township - Wide Ratepayers' Organization

VANDORF — Lawrence Hennessey, newly-elected deputy-reeve of Whitchurch Township, has come out in favor of a single ratepayers' association, representing the entire municipality. Mr. Hennessey suggested that Council should lend support to such an organization.

Reeve Stewart Burnett said that in his opinion,

there was no obligation on the part of council members to establish such a group. Councillor, Mrs. Betty Van Nostrand said that in name, there were already three such associations in existence at Musselman's Lake, Preston's Lake and Lake Wilcox.

Others contended that specific areas had particular problems but residents of one weren't

particularly interested in issues of another.

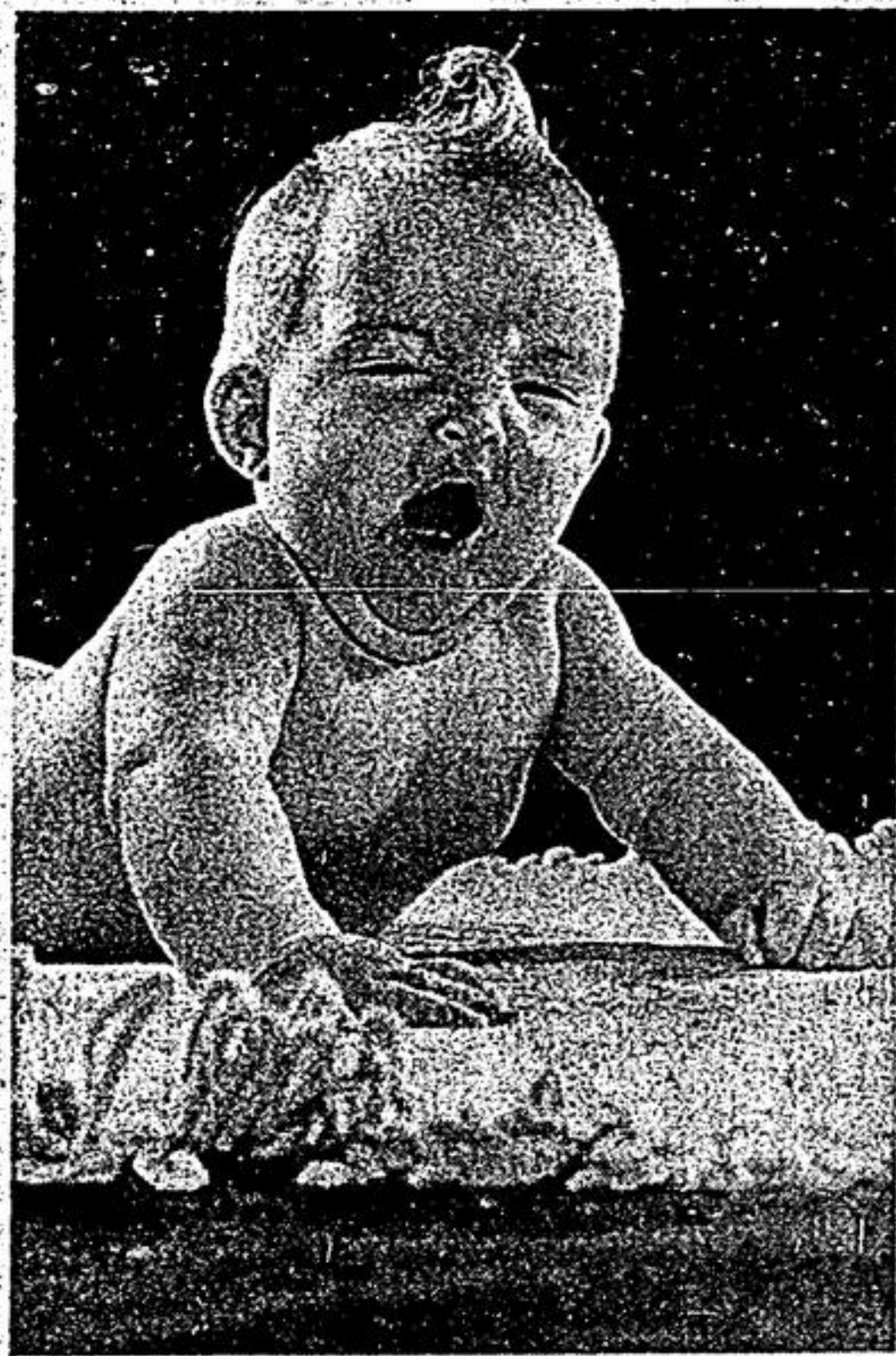

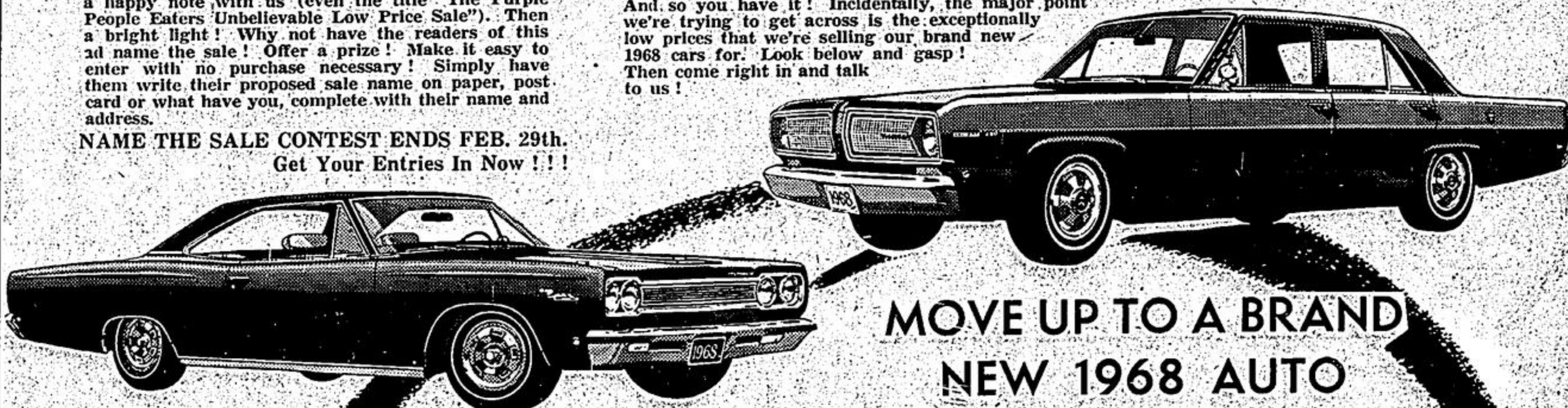

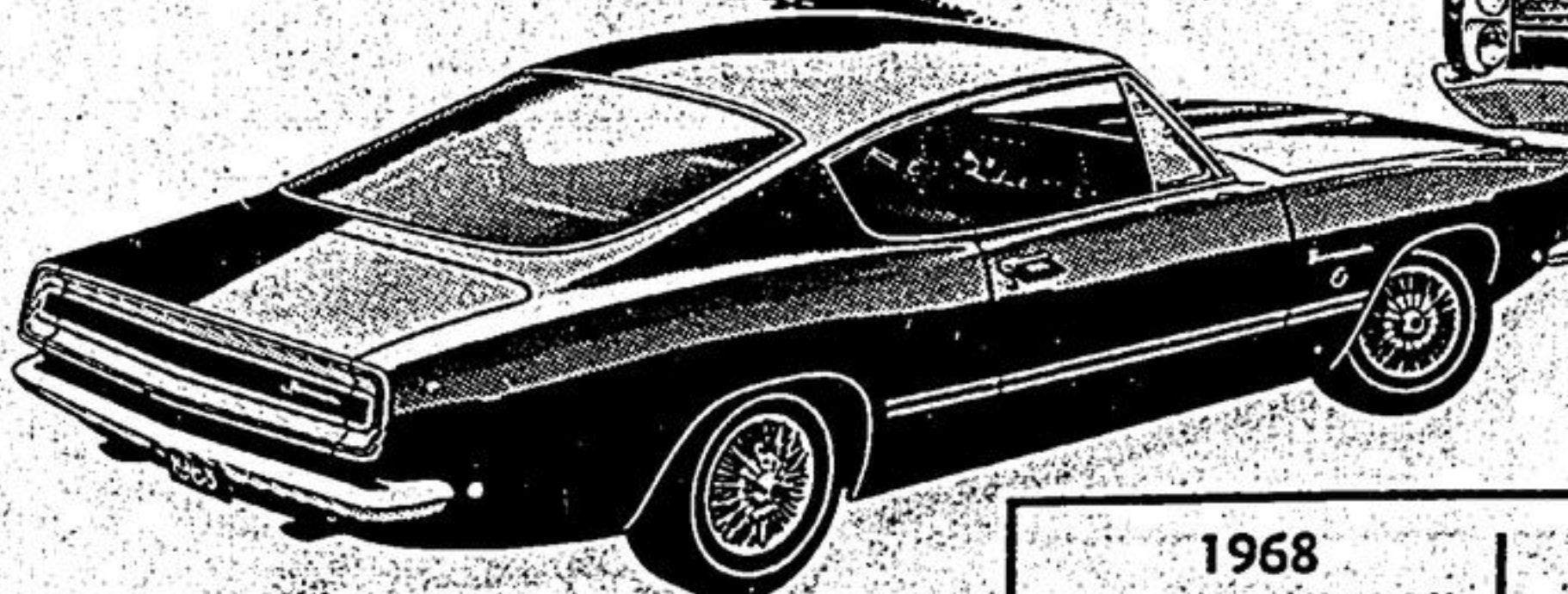
