Owners Protest Closing of Road Allowance

PICKERING - Paul Mingay, Markham solicitor, represented a group of owners protesting the closing of the road allowance between Lots 8 and 9 in Concession 8.

Reeve Williams referred to the parcel leading to the property of Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Pugh as "path" or "field" and said that even if they were closed, the owners would have access to and from their properties.

Councillor Victor Rudik said that the division into lots created a need, and Mr. Mingay said the need was always there, for Mr. Hoskins had to use this road to get to the back of his property.
