Being married in the 112 year old church which used to stand at Dufferin Street and Steeles Avenue are Jane Diane Barr, 23, of 393 Horsham Avenue and Charles Norman Saunders, 24, of 445 Hounslow Avenue, both of Willowdale. Mr. Saunders is a former employee of Black Creek Pioneer Village and attended the church as a boy when it was at its original site. The wedding is to be performed by the Rev. Alexander McLean of Willowdale Presbyterian Church, the bride's minister. This will be the second wedding solemnized at the church since it was moved to Black Creek Pioneer Village eight years ago.

Approve 69 new lots at Unionville

MARKHAM TWP. — Markham Township Council has passed a resolution approving development of 69 lots owned by Hengran Developments Ltd., north of Varley Village at Unionville. Governed by Amendment No. 15 to the Official Plan of the township, development of these lots was held up for lack of school accommodation, but this week council members said the new senior school at Unionville will be completed by January, 1969, and agreed to accept a recommendation of Planning Board to implement a by-law. Hengran has agreed to supply storm and sanitary sewers and water to the school site, and a road is to be deeded according to a survey. They have also agreed to move these services if they do not conform to a plan of subdivision when approved.
