Promoted by hydro to fill Lambton post

STOUFFVILLE — A widely known, popular member of Hydro's Central Region office, Charles Anton Boss, 41, senior materials clerk, has been promoted and transferred to the position of Stores Supervisor at Lambton G.S. project, Sarnia, in Western Region. He took over his new post recently.

During the eleven and one-half years that he has been connected with Central Region, Charlie Boss has been active in staff activities. He was the dynamic, hard working and imaginative president of the Central Region Social Club. He also found time for outside activities and was Executive Manager of the Stouffville Minor Hockey League and was active in Scouting as a leader. He and his wife, who resided in Stouffville, were well known for their interest in children. They have presently two youngsters from the Catholic Children's Aid Society staying with them as part of their family, which includes four children of their own.

A guard stopped me and told me I had no right to get into the House of Commons as it was not open. He asked me what I was doing there as it was not open. I indicated that I was a Member of Parliament and wanted to get into my office to do some work. With that he was very apologetic and escorted me to my office, which, of course, was locked — I did not have a key. After a few more embarrassing moments, the guard, finally convinced that I really was a Member, opened the door and let me into my office!

I had another embarrassing thing happen at the opening of the Sutton Fair. Pat and I had both been invited to attend a luncheon prior to the opening and a very distinguished gentleman came over to congratulate me on my election. I thought he looked rather familiar but could not remember the name. Much to my embarrassment I found he was the former Lieutenant Governor of Ontario, Earle Rowe.
