

Markham area drover forty years

MARKHAM—The Markham area lost one of its best known and most highly respected long-time residents in the passing, Sept. 8 of Joseph Gordon Lunau, 16th Avenue, Markham, R.R. 2.

Mr. Lunau, a district drover for 41 years, was active to the day he died. He would have wanted it no other way, for he had been active all his life.

Mr. Lunau was a descendent of staunch pioneer stock, dating back to 1794 when his great-grandfather, Joachim Lunau arrived in Markham Township and settled on 200 acres of Crown Land at lot 14, conc. 2, August 20, 1804.

Joachim's son, John Jacob donated the lot where the Bethel (Lunau) Cemetery is now located at conc. 5.

In 1886, his great-grandfather, Joseph Lunau bought property at lot 17, conc. 8 from Henry Crosby. J. Gordon was born on this farm, March 16, 1903, son of Reuben Lunau and Margaret McCall. His great-grandfather on his mother's side was George Bell, uncle of Alexander Graham Bell, founder of the telephone. Gordon Lunau attended school at S.S. No. 16, Mount Joy.

After attending the Toronto Business College, he was employed as an estimator with W. J. McGuire Plumbing. On his return to Markham, he worked as a clerk and delivery man at Percy Wilson's store in Locust Hill. He started up as a drover in 1927.

Mr. Lunau was an ardent sports fan, particularly hockey and horse racing. He served on the executive of the Markham "Millionaires" for several seasons. He was President of the Markham Fair Board in 1954 and on the board of directors over 25 years. He was a charter member of the Markham - Unionville Lions Club and a member of Niomi Lodge No. 116, I.O.O.F., for 39 years. A 25 year jewel was a proud possession. He was also a

lifelong Liberal in politics. In the early 1930's, Mr. Lunau served as an assistant on the Markham Village police department with Harry Johnson, The chief at that time was Jimmy Walker. He was a livestock valuator for the Township of Markham for many years.

Surviving besides his wife, the former Aileen Lewis is one son, John, at home. Mr. and Mrs. Lunau were married, August 29, 1929 and celebrated their 39th wedding anniversary recently.

The service, Sept. 11 from the Dixon Funeral Home, Markham was one of Markham's largest indicating the respect held for the deceased in the community. The more than 100 floral arrangements were most beautiful. Rev. Donald Parr of St. Andrews United Church was in charge. Interment was in Elmwood Cemetery, Markham.

Nomination Nov. 18 Board of education

YORK COUNTY — The nomination of members to serve on York County's new Board of Education will be held Nov. 18. Elections, where necessary, will be arranged for Dec. 2 and the board will hold its first meeting Dec. 9 although the old area system will not be dissolved officially until Jan. 1.

Information on the proposed organization of the County Education Board was outlined at a meeting in Aurora, Sept. 5.

A breakdown of trustee representation in the 14 municipalities will be as follows: Aurora 1; East Gwillimbury, 1; King Twp. 2; Markham Twp. 3; Markham Village, 1; Newmarket, 1; North Gwillimbury, 1; Richmond Hill, 2; Stouffville/Whitchurch, 1; Sutton-Georgina, 1; Woodbridge-Vaughan, 3; Separate School, 1.

It is reported that Michael Oden of Whitchurch TSA and John McMurray, Elm Road, Stouffville, will allow their names to stand for election. Neither trustee has yet signified his intentions. Both are members of the York County Interim School Organization Committee.

The Thornhaven School for Retarded will also come under the jurisdiction of the new County education system.
