Pickering council

Considers 3 year term

PICKERING TWP. — Are you in favor of a three-year term for the municipal council? This question will be on the county school board election ballot in Pickering Township, if the recommendation made by council in committee of the whole on Oct. 15 is approved by council in regular session. It is the opinion of Deputy Reeve Ron Chatten that the proposed school board will not retain their two year term, but go to a three year term. "This will be exactly in step with Metro," said Councillor John Kruger, who has made a notice of motion to amalgamate with Metro Toronto in the regional government proposals. "If we can ask the question on the ballot now, it will fit like a glove." "Why not put the question of joining Metro to the people at the same time?" queried councillor Donald Beer. Even if the three-year term question is answered in the affirmative, it will not apply to the present council.

Information 'hidden' claims reeve

PICKERING TWP. — Reeve John Williams of Pickering Township has charged that information vital to the Township in its appeal against the equalized County assessment, was being withheld by the County Assessment Department. Despite this action, he warned the township would secure the data through other channels at greater cost. "We will press for costs in this action so the county will have to pay any way," he said.

He said the township would not be proceeding with the action unless it was confident it would succeed. Some working papers dealing with the working out of the equalized assessment had been destroyed the year after they were used. It was his opinion such papers should be retained for at least 10 years.

Commenting that it was up to the county to decide on such matters, Reeve Gordon Hanna of Whitby said his municipality might be in a similar position in the future. "We are not here to put one municipality against another. This information should not be withheld."



Reeve John Williams said if any municipality wanted information in the possession of the assessment department it should be made available. However, a request for information, vital to its case, had been refused "apparently due to the action of some shadow committee."

Reeve Williams said his council had received a letter from its solicitor stating the county had refused to produce certain documents. He contended a situation was being created whereby many municipalities would be unable to launch appeals. The Pickering Township appeal would benefit other municipalities, he said. "We were told we could have pertinent information relating only to Pickering Township and nothing more. It appears something is being hidden," Reeve Williams said.
