Approve in principle

Pickering 'estate' subdivision

PICKERING TWP. — Pickering Twp. Council has approved in principle a new subdivision north of conc. 7 east of the Brock Road, but not unanimously. Councillors Victor Rudik and John Kruger opposed the motion. "Procedurally it is wrong," he said. "I have made a mistake. I think we are slapping our planning board in the face." The planning board has not approved the subdivision, the plans for which were outlined last May. By agreeing in principle, Rudik said that "we are begging them to go along with this proposal." He believed that the staff should submit detailed reports before council commits itself. Councillor Donald Kitchen said it wasn't fair for a committee of the whole to say one thing and then say "maybe we shouldn't have." "It came before the Planning Board in May," said

Councillor Arthur King. "I say this township is stagnant. We are not keeping abreast if we don't take on areas of development which will more than support itself. I see no reason now to change my mind providing safeguards are followed through." The proposed development is for \$47,000 (average) homes on wooded, one- and two-acre lots east from the Brock Road as far as Cherry Downs Golf Course.

PICKERING TWP. — On the original voters list for the Twp. of Pickering, Councillor John Kruger's name has been omitted. "I've been classified as an alien," councillor Kruger admitted. He also said he would take steps to have the error corrected. "I'm an Australian," he said, "a British subject. We should tell the County what British subjects are. Someone apparently does not understand what the British Empire includes." Mr. Kruger said that even Aborigines are British subjects.

He appealed to council to have the zoning amended on compassionate grounds. "It would open the flood gates at this time," commented councillor John Kruger. "It could have been done in 1958."
