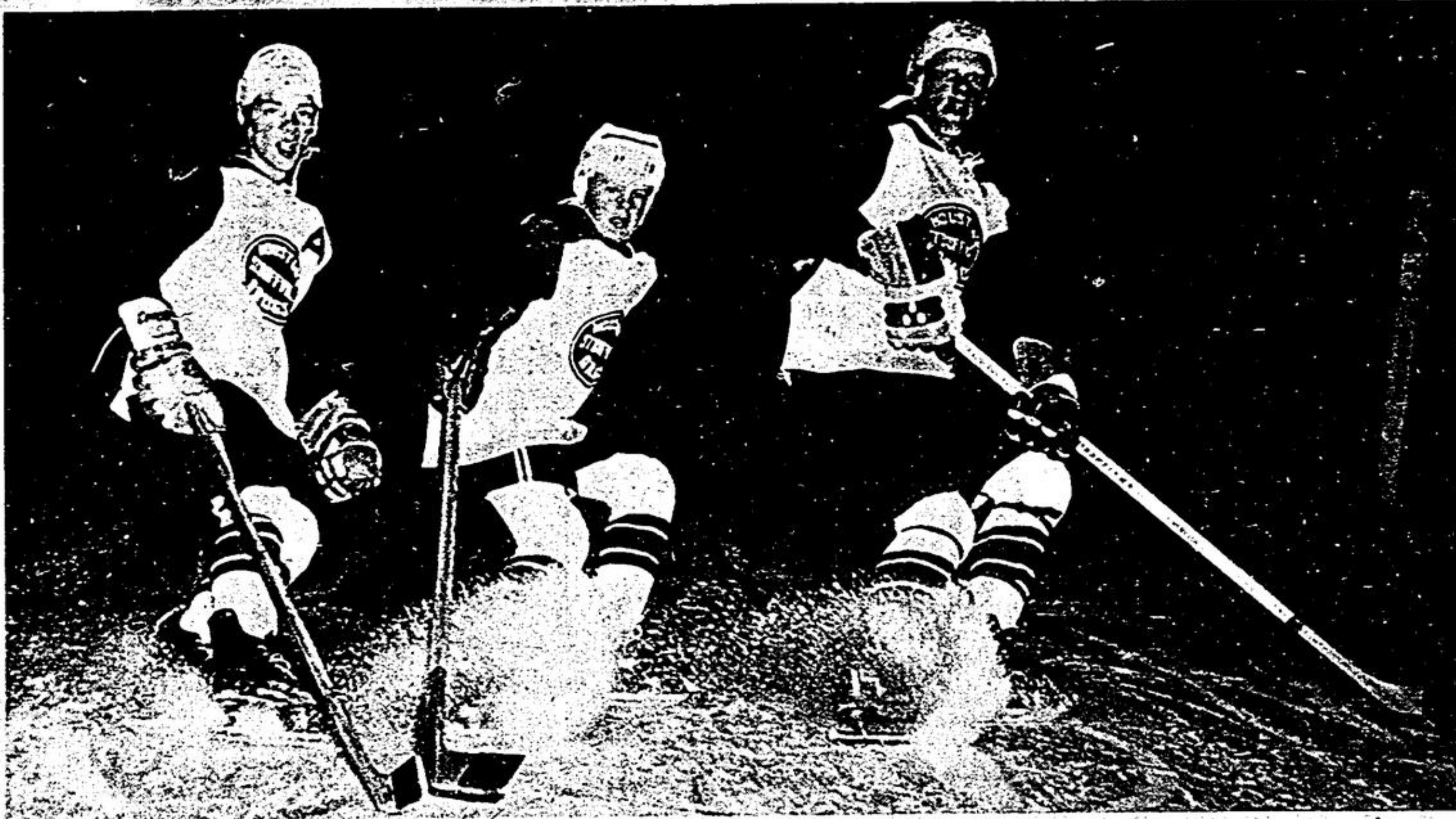


# Stouffville Minor Hockey Week - January 24th - 30th
