**PICKERING TWP.** — Hon. Darcy McKeough, Minister of Municipal Affairs is not prepared to consider the lifting of the 100 building permit restriction in the Twp. of Pickering. Nor will he agree to council's request to hold up all subdivisions without industrial assurance to offset residential assessment.

In a letter to the Clerk Mr. McKeough suggested that there was much to be discussed in connection with both proposals. Councillor John Kruger said that members should be satisfied through the knowledge that their request had been studied. He said that future discussions with the Minister could possibly solve some of Pickering's problems.
