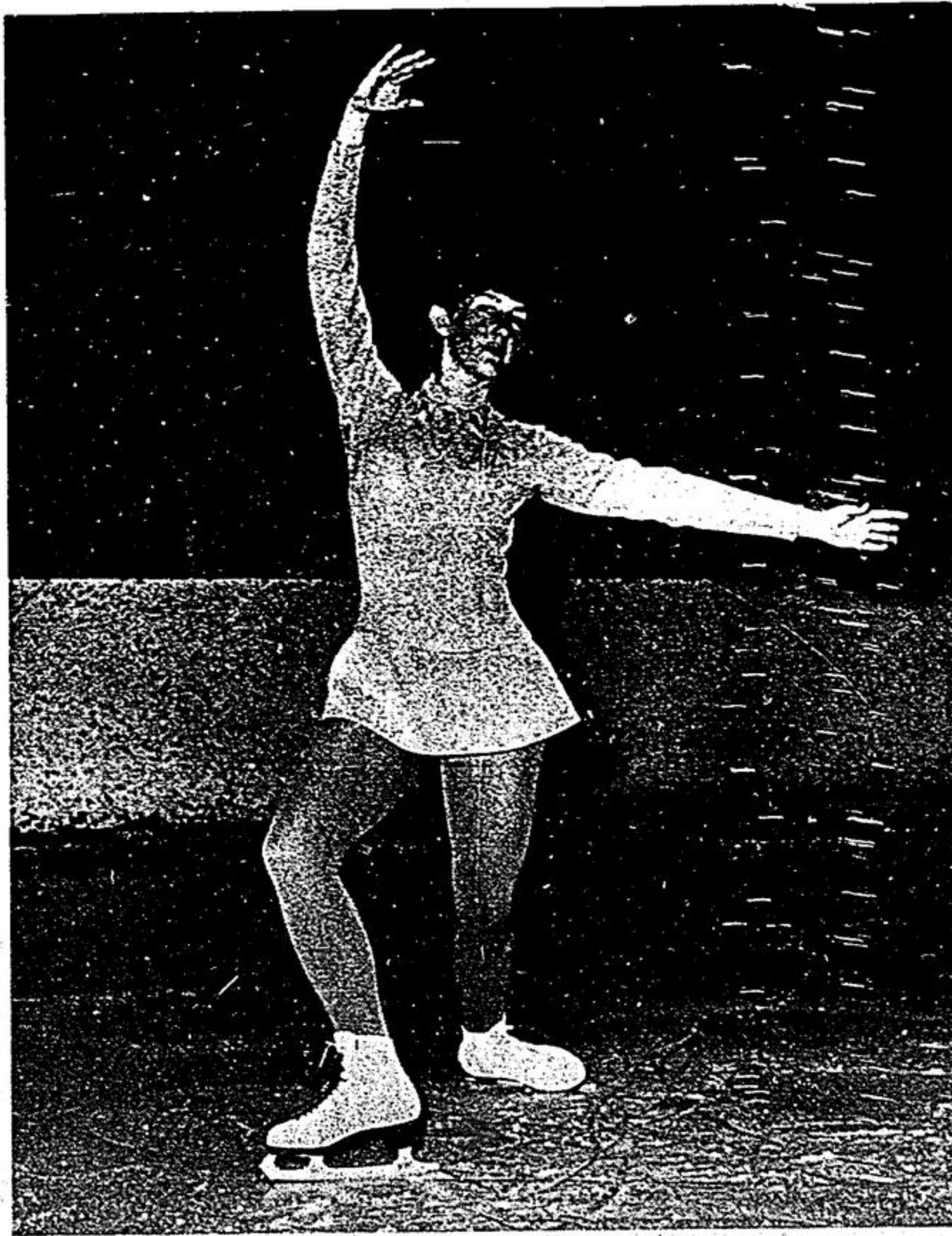


# Figure skaters try bronze and silver tests at Markham

## 'Green light' to Markham plaza

MARKHAM — Markham Town council has given the go-ahead for the construction of a new plaza at the former Butcher property, Hwy. No. 7 and conc. 7.

The application was approved at a meeting Monday.

A start on the project awaits only Ontario Municipal Board approval and this is anticipated with no delay.

The developer, Morris Gruda, contemplates the erection of a restaurant, a retail grocery store, a

gift shop, dry cleaning establishment, jewellery store, hardware store, paint and wallpaper store, a drug store and service station.

In addition, council will permit the building of professional offices and a bank on the same site.

**Alter Pool By-Law**  
A minor alteration has been written into the by-law governing the protection of backyard private swimming pools in Markham. Under the amendment, one wall of the

house will be considered a legal barrier.

The type of fence is clearly stipulated and entrance gates must be equipped with a locking device and kept secured when the pool is not in use.

Violations of any part of the by-law carries a fine of up to \$300 exclusive of costs for each offense.

**Erosion Problem**  
An erosion problem has occurred on the east bank of the Rouge River adjacent to the site of Markham Dist. High School.

In an effort to correct this situation, R. V. Anderson and Associates have been instructed to provide an estimate on the cost of protecting this area. The study, to cost about \$2,000, will be available in four weeks.

As this matter falls into the category of conservation, the municipality will share 25 percent of the amount and the province, 75 percent.

The town's portion will be 'reimbursed' by the York County Board of Education.
