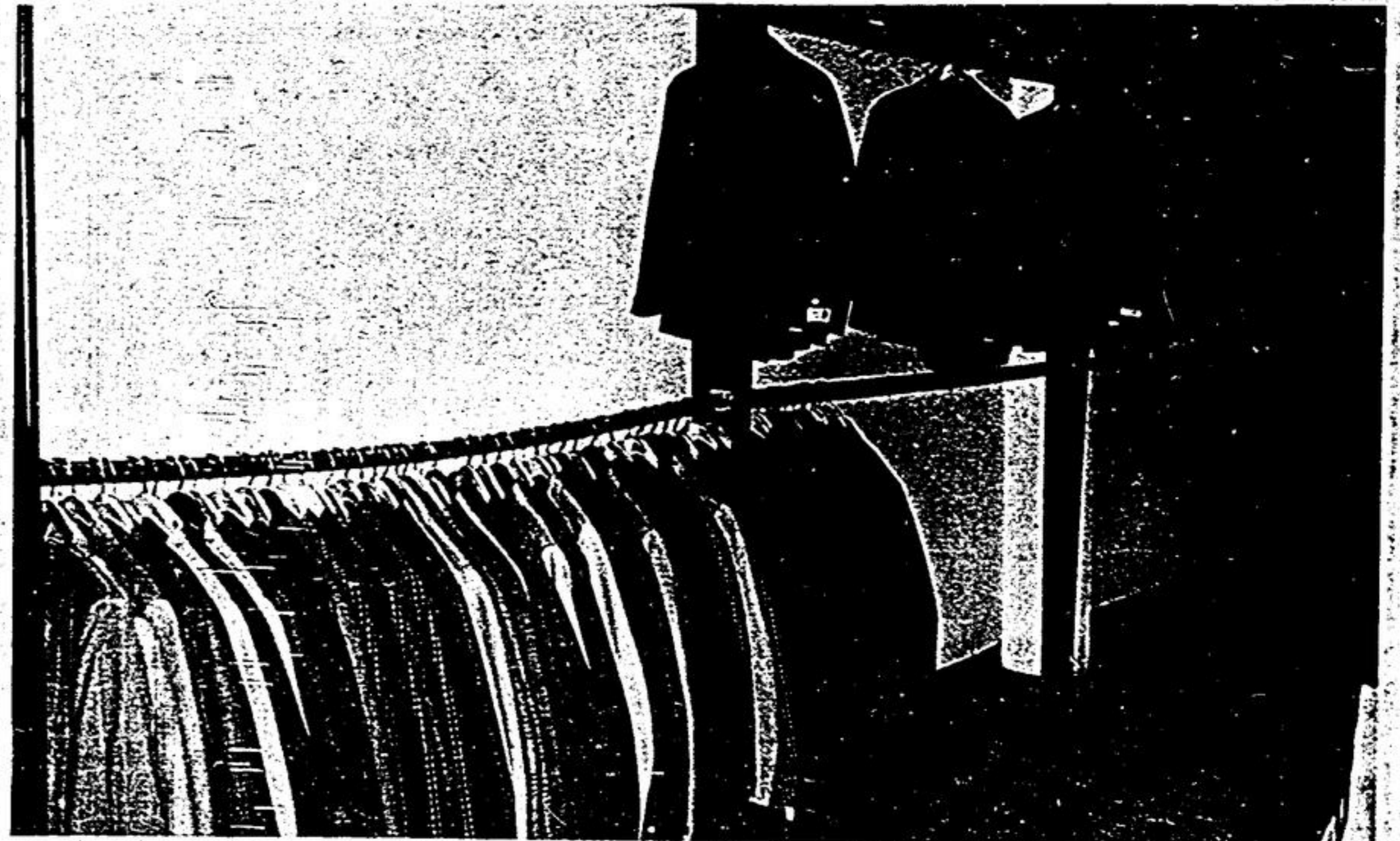


A break-in at Appleton's Men's Wear in the Markham Shopping Centre, March 16 cleaned out this section of clothing.
