Mr. Max Hazel has returned after spending several months with relatives in Germany.

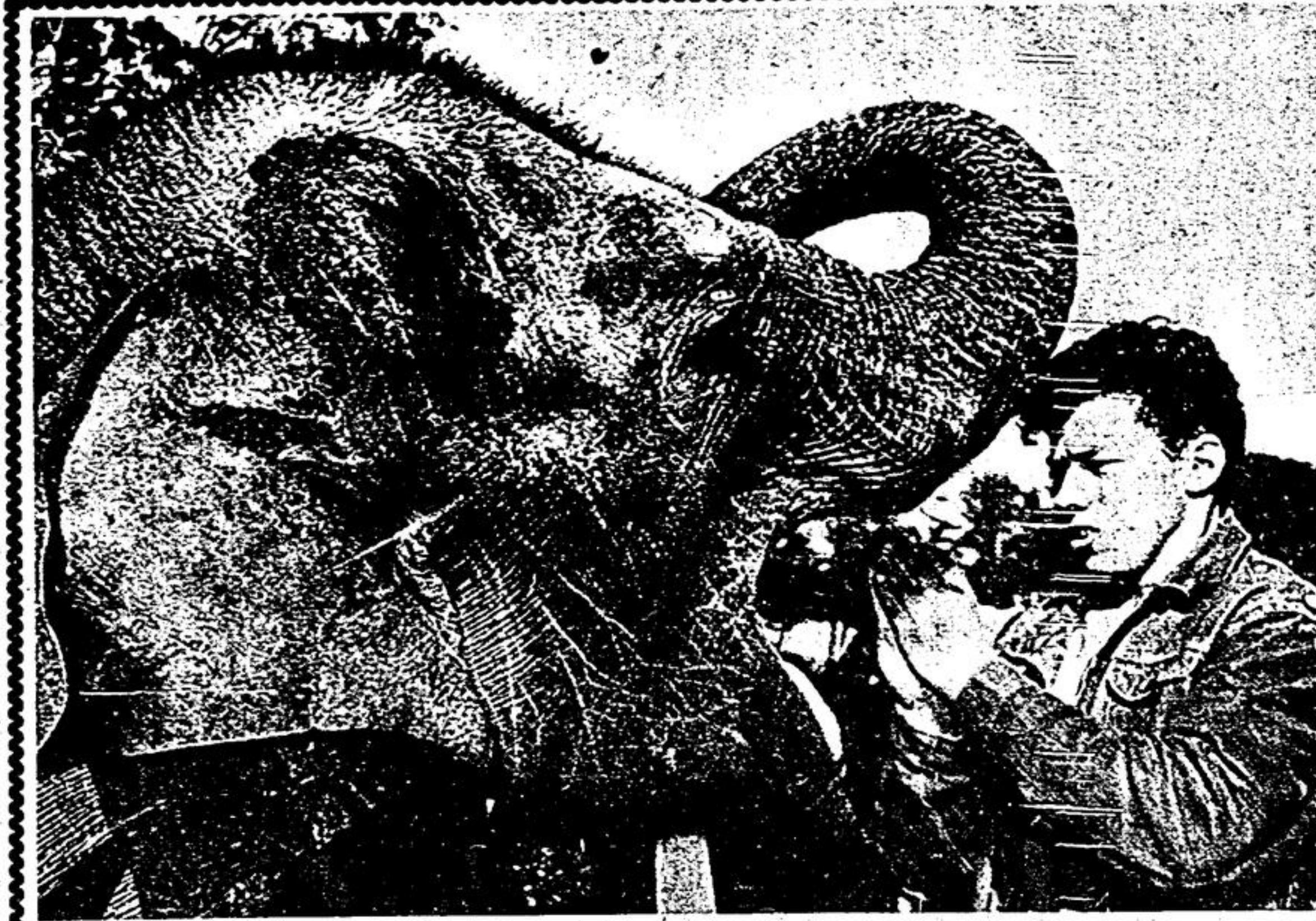
