NOTICE OF APPLICATION to the Ontario Municipal Board by The Corporation of the Township of Pickering for approval of a by-law to regulate land use passed pursuant to Section 30 of The Planning Act.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Pickering intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 30 of The Planning Act for approval of By-law 3712 passed on the 6th day of October, 1969. A copy of the by-law is published herewith. A note giving an explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law and stating the lands affected thereby is also published herewith.

Any person interested may, within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Pickering notice of his objection to approval of the said by-law together with a statement of the grounds of such objection.

Any person wishing to support the application for approval of the by-law may, within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Pickering notice of his support for approval of the said by-law together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held, giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

The Ontario Municipal Board may approve of the said by-law but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have given an objection, or notice of support, and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent.

The last date for filing objections will be January 22nd, 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This by-law amends the land use regulations of Pickering Township by further limiting and clarifying service stations and excluding "gas bars"; broadening the definition of "livestock" and prohibiting the keeping of same in any but agricultural areas of over five acres; and requiring that any buildings to be erected shall front on an opened and maintained public street.
