## Altona sewage plant opposed by O.W.R.C.

**UXBRIDGE TWP.** - A proposed sewage disposal plant on a branch of Duffin Creek to serve a phase of the planned Century City development, has been turned down by the Ontario Water Resources Commission.

The rejection by O.W.R.C. was contained in a letter to Pickering Twp. Council, April 20.

The selected site of the plant is south of Altona.

Earlier, Pickering had registered opposition to the buildup, claiming it would not benefit the township as a whole. Members of both Council and Planning Board agree that a disposal plant, to serve a

development of such magnitude, should be located on the shoreline of Lake Ontario.

The Commission informed Pickering that a copy of their decision would be sent to Hon. D'Arcy McKeough, Minister of Municipal Affairs.

Further rejection has also been received from the Village of Port Perry.

**\$25,000 anonymous gift**  
 YORK CTY. - A member of a long-established Newmarket family has made an anonymous donation of \$25,000 to the fund drive to raise \$209,400 for Blue Hills Academy.

Announcement of the gifts came one week after the United Church of Canada presented Blue Hills with a \$10,000 gift and a \$20,000 interest-free loan.

Blue Hills Academy is a residential treatment centre for emotionally disturbed children and is the first facility of its kind in York County. It is located on the CFRB Sideroad about 1 1/2 miles west of Yonge St. Academy officials

emphasized that the donor wished to remain anonymous but expressed elation over receipt of the \$25,000 gift.

"What this gift tells us is that there are people in this county who are concerned about our young people and believe in what

Blue Hills Academy is trying to do to meet the needs of emotionally disturbed children in York County," said Bob Silcox, general chairman of the Academy's fund drive.

D. Russell MacDonald, Blue Hills board of

directors, expressed the hope for continued support for the drive.

Mr. MacDonald said doctors and educators of York County have already indicated support and that dentists and lawyers were in the process of

organizing to help the drive.

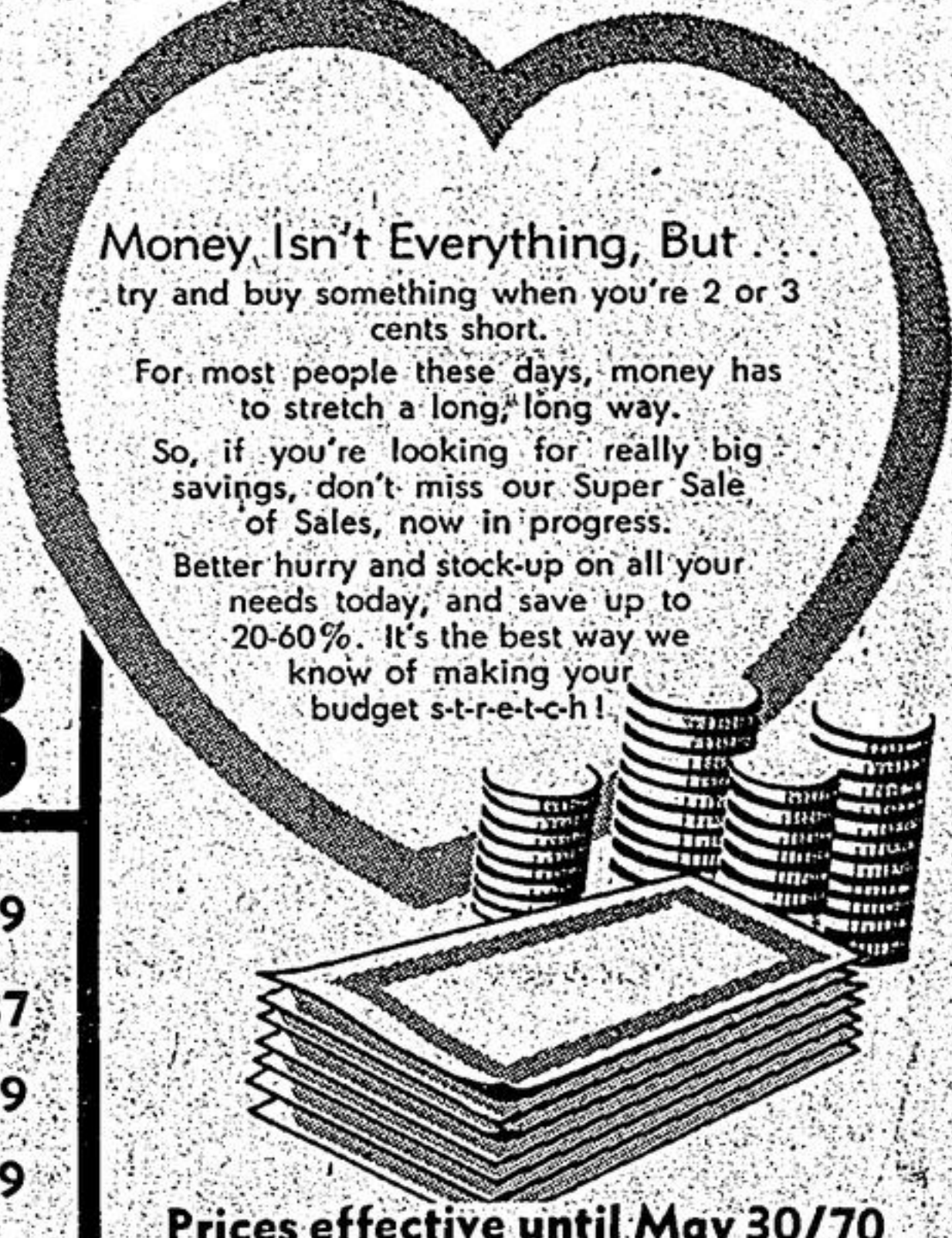
