Purchase school site

MARKHAM - Members of the York County Board of Education at their April 27 meeting approved a capital expenditure of \$76,000 for a 4.11 acres of land for an elementary school adjacent to the Markham District High School property. This is to serve the 37 acre Ian Hardcastle development.

The site was acquired at a price of \$18,000 per acre, including services. In addition, a further 2,002 acres adjoining the property was previously acquired as an addition to the Markham District High School site at a price of \$12,500 per acre, bringing the average price per acre for the whole 6.112 acres to \$16,198.

It was noted that the requirement of 6.112 acres for school sites from a 37.43 acre development was in excess of normal demands and that for this reason the board could be expected to pay a premium price for the land.

The 4.11 acre site for the elementary school is a

landlocked parcel and will be served by two 15-foot walkways.
