### Bloomington centenarian

BLOOMINGTON — It is difficult to think of the hamlet of Bloomington without the firm hand and friendly smile of its oldest resident, Will Fockler. For he was, so much a part of the community. He was the community past and present.

Mr. Fockler passed away, May 16 in York County Hospital, Newmarket, a loss that has been keenly felt by everyone. He was in his 101st year.

Mr. Fockler was a part of everything upstanding and good, including his

church where he served as choir leader and Sunday School Superintendent for many years. He even helped to build it, teaming materials to the site by horse and wagon.

Keeping active was his greatest joy and neighbors often marvelled to see him cutting grass or hoeing his garden. On the occasion of his 100th birthday, Oct. 31, 1969, he received more than 70 cards from well-wishers over a wide area. A family gathering was

held in his honor.

Mr. Fockler was born near Bloomington, the son of Jacob and Delilah Fockler and one in a family of three boys. A brother, Rev. C.E. Fockler lives in Markham. A second brother, H.H. Fockler of Toronto is deceased. Mrs. Fockler, the former Alberta Forsyth passed away 6 years ago at the age of 91.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. G.M. McCormack, (Merle), R.R.2, Stouffville; Mrs. H.H. Tomlinson (Alta), of Weston; Mrs. Robert Leask (Aleta), of Greenbank; seven grandchildren and fourteen great grandchildren.

The funeral service was held May 19 from the Bloomington Associated Gospel Church with the pastor, Rev. Roy Langford in charge. Interment was in Bloomington Cemetery. The pall bearers were Vince Wagg, Noel Storry, Elmer Burnett, Kenneth Trammer, Tom White and Robert Mills.

### Award school bus contracts

YORK CTY. — School bus contracts for the year 1970-71 have been awarded by the York County Board of Education. Tenders were opened May 22.

Eight bids were received, two of which were disqualified as they did not meet the conditions of tender. Two hundred and two busses will be operated daily by the board.

In area 2 (Stouffville, Whitechurch, King and Aurora), the contract was awarded to a consortium of Trailways of Canada Ltd., and Langdons Coach Lines Ltd.

In area 4 (Markham town and township, Richmond Hill and Vaughan), the contract has been awarded Trailways of Canada Ltd.

Area 2 costs per day for bus transportation will be \$2,485, as compared to \$2,260 in 1969-70. In area 4, the cost will be up to \$1,172 from \$1,085.
